

LMP has always placed safety first, and we intend to exceed the safety precautions for COVID-19 and other Low Risk Recreational Activities. As such, there will be several changes to restrict the number of people on the property, parking and access to the workshop building. Registration and sign-in will be accomplished with no physical interaction. The initial plans are to only offer open practice sessions, we will look to start racing as it can be accomplished in a safe manner. Although we generally don't get spectators, none will be allowed. In addition, only one mechanic or support person from the same household or riding in the same vehicle to the track will be allowed per driver. All safety measures will be in accordance or exceed State and Local mandates. Attendee numbers will be strictly controlled and limited for social distancing management.

Track Background

As confirmed by the NY Department of Labor, LMP is NOT an amusement park, nor do we rent out karts, lend out helmets etc. We are recognized as a formal racetrack where individual LMP Club Racers bring their own race karts and protective gear in order to drive on the fully sanctioned racetrack. While we accommodate all classes (Kid Kart 5~7yo, Cadet Kart 8~12yo, Junior Kart 12~15yo and Senior 15yo through Adult), the highest majority of our Club Racers are in the Senior adult class, many of whom also have their children with them racing in the Junior (12~15yo) and a number in the Cadet class (8~12yo).

The sport of kart racing is certainly very safe from a social distancing standpoint as all LMP Club Racers as a requirement to use the facility, must wear heavy protective gear including full faced helmets, gloves and race suits. Karts only accommodate the driver (single seat), so again, there are no social distancing concerns while driving making it safer from a Covid-19 perspective than even playing golf or pleasure boating and therefore certainly falls within a "Low Risk Recreational Outdoor Activity".

This will be a learning process for all parties, and we appreciate your patience during this time. Our aim is to provide you a safe place to pursue professional karting as a safe low risk outdoor recreational activity. Please note the following rules:

I. Standing Rules

1. Don't come if you might have been exposed

If you have a headache, are feverish, have a cough, a sore throat, are fatigued, have aches and pains, etc., don't come to LMP. If you have been around someone with those symptoms in the last two weeks, don't come to LMP.

2. Practice social distancing and sanitization

We will rigidly practice social distancing. Once you drive into the pits, you will see the pit area marked with pit spots at least six feet away from the next. Please select an open pit

spot to maintain a safe distance while pitting and working on your kart between runs. We will remain six feet away from you at all times and in accordance with State requirements, will require face masks (to protect you and those around you) when social distancing is not possible. Please use the same six-foot rule for all of your personal interactions with others. Do not congregate in groups. If we see groups forming and non-adherence to the six-foot rule, you will be asked to split up, if we have to warn you a second time, you will be asked to pack up and leave. Think of it as a waived black flag warning and then a full black flag on the track, this is for yours and everyone else's safety.

3. Workshop and Restroom facilities

We will regularly sanitize the restrooms as well as keep the extraction fans running at all times to maintain circulation of clean air, please also make sure you're wearing a mask when using the facilities, this is for yours and everyone else's protection. We also ask that to ensure the restroom is clean for you and those visiting afterward, that after you use the facilities, you take one of the sanitizer wipes located in each restroom and wipe down surfaces you may have touched. A trash can will be located outside the restrooms for disposal of the used wipe. Beak & Skiff hand sanitizer will also be located throughout the facility for your use and protection.

No one will be permitted inside the workshop. Any parts, tires, fuel, oil etc. needed can be requested and will be delivered to your pit spot or outside the shop (curb-side) while maintaining social distancing. The compressed air station usually located by the control tower will not be available until further notice. We can fill your air cans and tires upon request while maintaining safe distancing guidelines.

4. Drive within your limits

We expect all drivers to dial it back a tenth. If you cannot enjoy driving without finding the limits of yourself or your kart, please don't come at this time. Please don't damage your kart or yourself, and force other people to risk their safety, because you drove over your head.

II. Daily Procedures

1. **Reservations** - Each LMP Club Racer must make a Reservation before arriving. You must not show up at the track unannounced. We need to control number of attendees at the track as a first step to managing social distancing with time/space control.
 - a. Make a reservation for your track session online at our website. We have modified our system limiting the number of drivers at any time at the facility. We will account for time between each session to allow you to pack-up and leave before the next session comes in if reservations warrant more than one session per day. You should not show up early and you should leave when your reserved session is completed. This system will allow us to manage numbers.
 - b. You may book back to back sessions, however – please don't overbook beyond your intended stay. We understand some LMP Club Racers will want to get more than one session in. No Problem, but please consider other LMP Club Racers. LMP reserves the right to limit LMP Club Racers to one session to allow more LMP Club Racers to enjoy some track time and the outdoors in a safe environment.

2. **Procedures**- Standing procedures for social distance apply to everyone – LMP Club Racers, their mechanic/support person, and the LMP staff. It is imperative we follow the rules for everyone’s safety.
- a. **Waiver** – Sign the waiver and keep the pen or bring your own pen to use.
 - b. **Covid-19 Policy** – Sign a copy of this Covid-19 Policy for you and your mechanic/support person.
 - c. **Mechanic/Support Person** – Only one mechanic or support person traveling in the same vehicle is allowed to attend with each LMP Club Racer.
 - d. **No Spectators** – No spectators are allowed to attend at this time, the viewing bleachers will also be closed off. This will help us maintain and manage social distancing for everyone’s safety.
 - e. **Fee** – Have your LMP Club Racer fee either in cash or check placed in an envelope with your name on the outside, push the envelope into the box provided.
 - f. **Pit Parking** – Park in the marked pit spots that will allow a minimum of six foot from other LMP Club Racers pit spots.
 - g. **Workshop** – Sorry, there will be no entry into the workshop until further notice.
 - h. **Track Sessions** –
 - i. **Kart Staging for your Session** – Bring your kart to the Hot Grid to stage ready for your session. Hot Grid Spots will be marked, please take an open and available spot to maintain social distancing while waiting for your session to start.
 - ii. **Starting your kart** – LMP Club Racers must have the ability to start their own karts (TaG) or have a mechanic or support person with them to start the kart, we will not allow fellow LMP Club Racers starting another’s kart for social distancing reasons.
 - iii. **Run Groups** – We will run groups by age/class as usual for safety reasons.
 - iv. **Safety Equipment** – As usual, all LMP Club Racers are required to wear mandated safety equipment, full faced helmets with visors, gloves, race-suit or jacket etc.
 - i. **Track Director** – On track sessions will be released from the Hot Grid and called back in from the track by the Track Director, adhere to all colored flags as usual. Track Director will also be monitoring for compliance with social distancing guidelines previously stated.
 - j. **Have Fun and Enjoy the Outdoors** – As has always been the case, we encourage a strong family atmosphere at LMP. At these trying times with so many restrictions in place, we hope you will enjoy the opportunity to be outdoors participating in a sport you enjoy and one that can be done safely and well within social distancing guidelines, please enjoy and stay safe.
