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Voting Facts

The **Primary Election** plays an important role in the electoral process. Candidates who are chosen during the Primary election process will appear on the General election ballot.

The **General Election** will determine who will hold county, state and federal offices.

In order to **register to vote**, you must be:

- A citizen of the United States;
- A resident of the State of Hawaii; and
- At least sixteen (16) years of age. *A person must be eighteen (18) years old by election day to vote.*

The **Office of the County Clerk** is where voters get registered. Turn in a completed voter registration application or go online to <https://mauicountyvotes.com> to get registered. Also, the County Clerk's Office, along with the assistance of the State Office of Elections, is responsible for carrying out the elections.

Identification (ID) is required in order to register to vote and vote at the early walk-in site.

Early walk-in voting occurs before the Primary and General elections. Voters "walk-in" to the designated areas between certain dates and vote early.



This is an option for voters who want an alternative way of casting their ballot.

Hawaii elections are conducted by **all mail voting**.

In 2020, a law was passed allowing all of Hawaii to vote by mail.


If you will be away from your residence during the election, you may fill out an **absentee application** to request a ballot be mailed to another address for the primary election, general election, or both.

Hawaii Votes by Mail

All registered voters will be automatically sent a ballot to their mailing address in Hawaii associated with their voter registration.

First time Voter Mailing this Application

If you are registering to vote for the first time in the State of Hawaii, mailing this application, and do not have a Hawaii Driver License, Hawaii State ID, or the last 4-digits of your Social Security Number, you are required to provide proof of identification. Proof of identification includes a copy of:

- A current and valid photo identification; or
- A current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document that shows your name and address.
