The TCAA scholarship grants are typically \$500 and will be paid directly to (reimbursed to) the flight school, education institution, or TCAA-vetted service provider you choose. If you are notified that you are a successful candidate, you will need to identify a training provider to TCAA as soon as possible. (Note: TCAA reserves the right to validate and approve providers.)

You will have one year from the date the monies are first distributed to your provider to expend the total amount awarded. If for any reason you are unable to expend all the funds within that timeframe, please contact TCAA to explain and ask for an extension of time.
