
Act of oblivion / by Robert Harris


Code name Sapphire / by Pam Jenoff


The matchmaker's gift / by Lynda Cohen Loigman


Every man a king / by Walter Mosley King Oliver bk. 2


Nona the ninth / by Tamsyn Muir Locked tomb bk. 3


Encore in death / by J.D. Robb In death bk. 56

Lying beside you / by Michael Robotham Cyrus Haven bk. 3



The cradle of ice / by James Rollins Moonfall bk. 2


