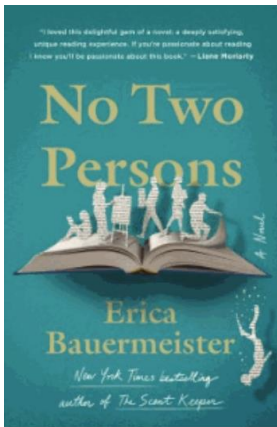
The boy who cried bear / by Kelley Armstrong

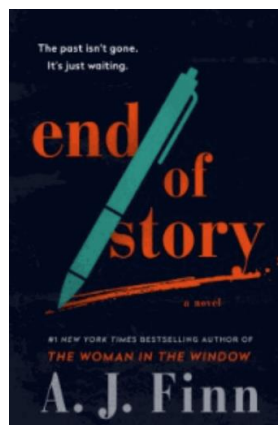
The heights /

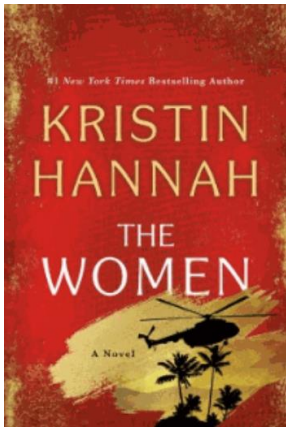
First born / by Will Dean

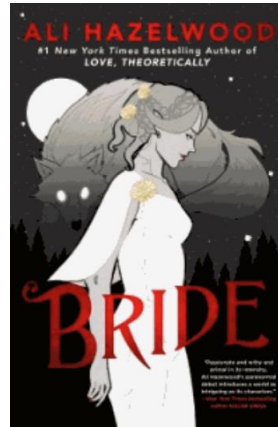
End of story / by A.J. Finn

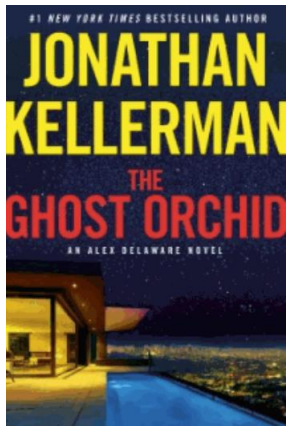

The Women is the story of one woman gone to war, but it shines a light on all women who put themselves in harm's way and whose sacrifice and commitment to their country has too often been forgotten.



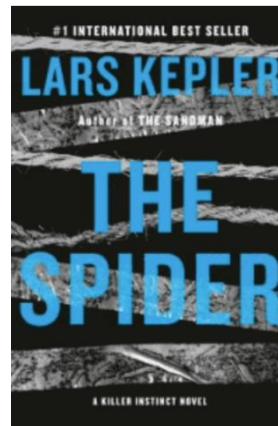

Attorney Robin Lockwood finds herself defending her old nemesis in a multiple murder case with too many suspects, where success might cost her own life.



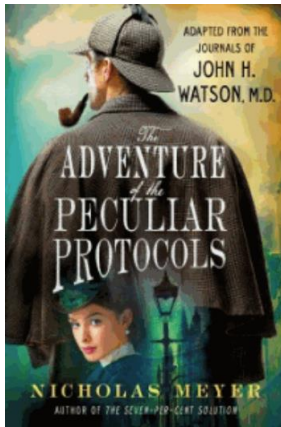

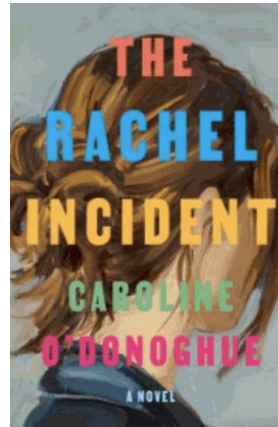

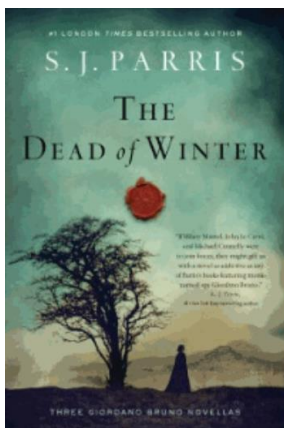
The adventure of the peculiar protocols: adapted from the journals of John H. Watson, M.D. / by Nicholas Meyer

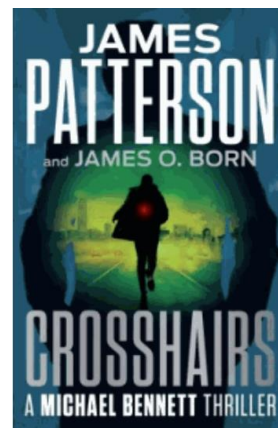
The Rachel incident / by Caroline O'Donoghue

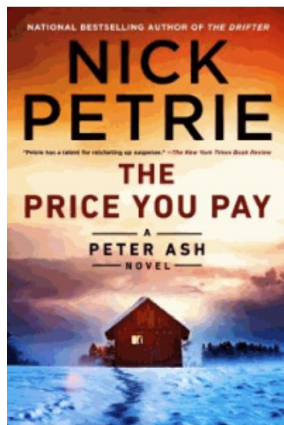
The dead of winter / by S.J. Parris

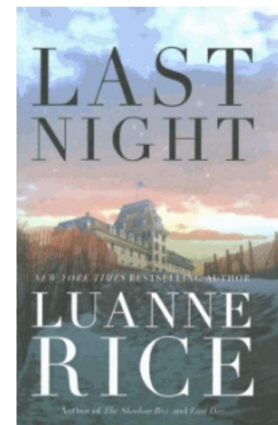
Crosshairs / by James Patterson Michael Bennett 16

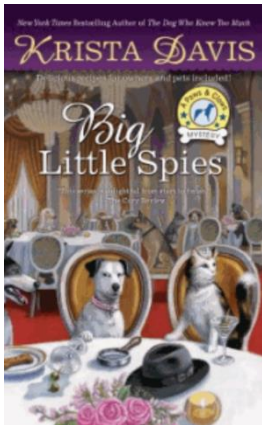
Peter Ash must follow his closest friend, Lewis, into the criminal underworld when secrets from the past threaten everything they hold dear.
