



Wise Gals: The Spies Who Built the CIA and Changed the Future of Espionage / by Nathalia Holt



American Sirens: The Incredible Story of the Black Men Who Became America's First Paramedics / by Kevin Hazzard



Existential Physics: a Scientist's Guide to Life's Biggest Questions / by Sabine Hossenfelder



Hossenfelder lays out how far physicists are on the way to answering these questions, where the current limits are, and what questions might well remain unanswerable forever.




