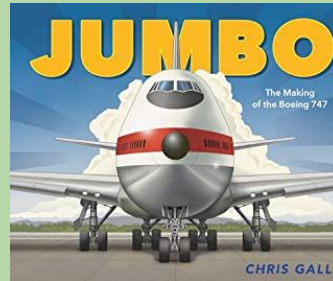


DECEMBER Non-Fiction
