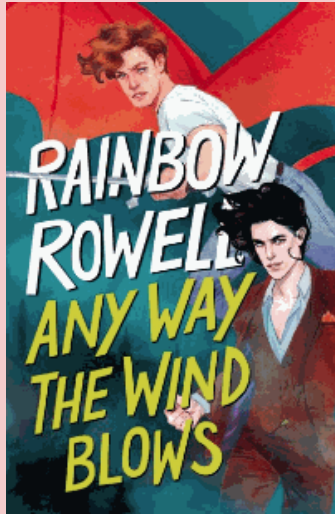


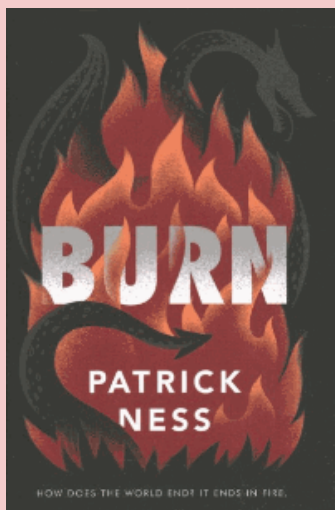
# JULY Teen Fiction

Adjusting to life in Isotte after fleeing Coroa, Hollis must help the Eastoffe family unseat a tyrannical king before war erupts.

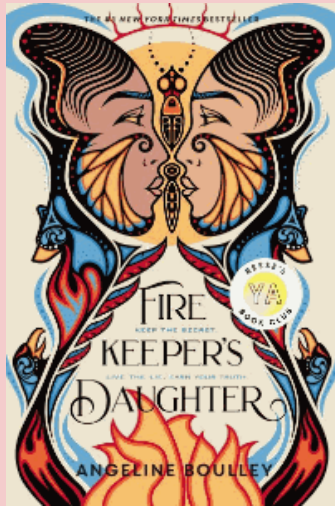
