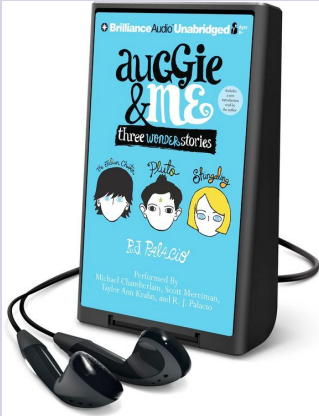


NEW JUVENILE AUDIO

Together, these three stories are a treasure for listeners who don't want to leave Auggie behind when they finish wonder.

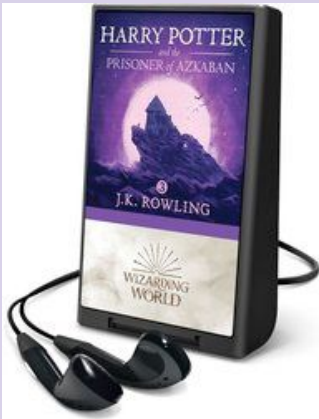
