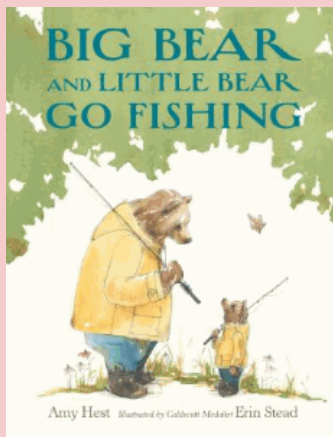
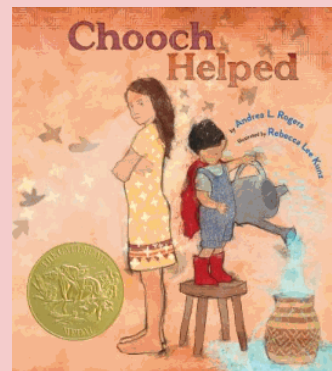

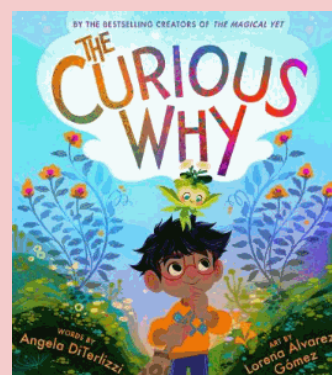
Chooch Helped

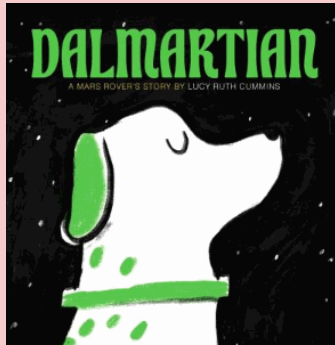
Clive Penguin

A cold, restless penguin looks for a way to warm up.



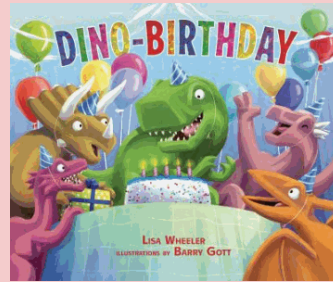
The Curious Why

A magical friend called the Curious Why encourages children's imaginations to fly, as they consider "how, what, where and



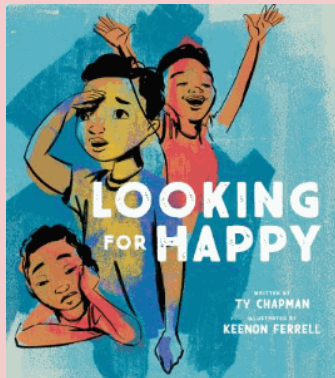
Dalmartian

An unlikely friendship develops when Stephen takes in an abandoned alien as his guest.



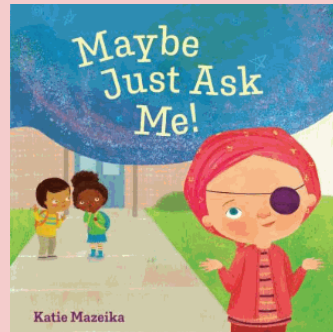
Dino-Birthday

Dinosaurs celebrate their birthdays with a variety of different parties, presents, and games depending on the season.



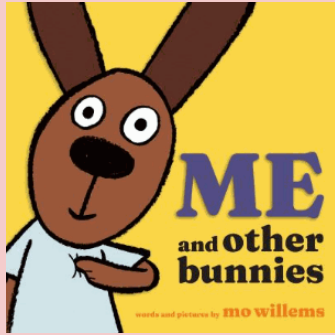
Looking For Happy

A young Black boy reflects on the natural ups and downs of his emotions.



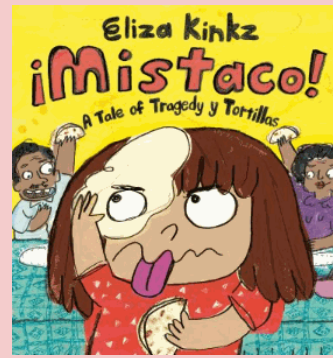
Maybe Just Ask Me

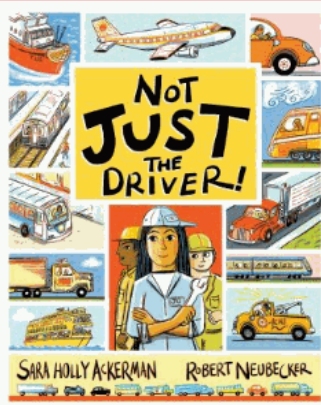
Me and Other Bunnies

"A group of bunnies come together and explore different pronouns."



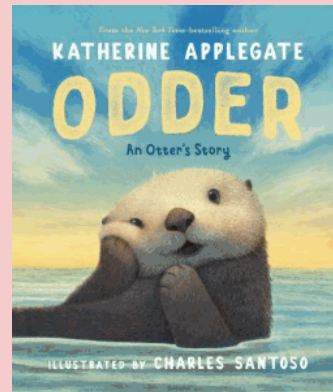
Mistaco a Tale of Tragedy y Tortillas

After a terrible day at school, Izzy's grandfather helps her turn things around by making "mistacos" and celebrating their mistakes.



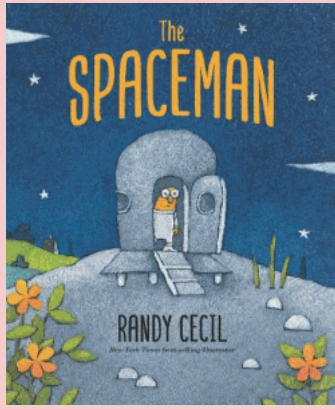
Not Just the Driver

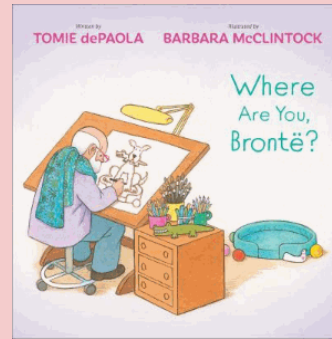
Odder : An Otter's Story

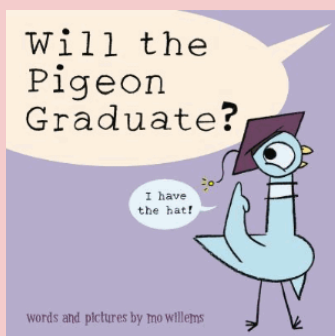
The Spaceman
