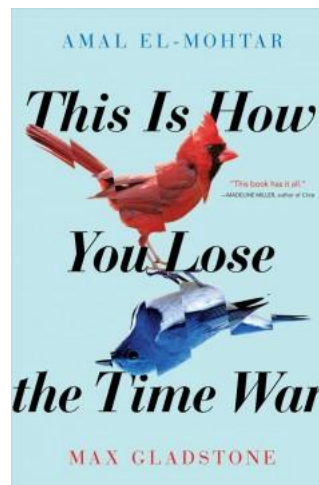
The little shop of found things

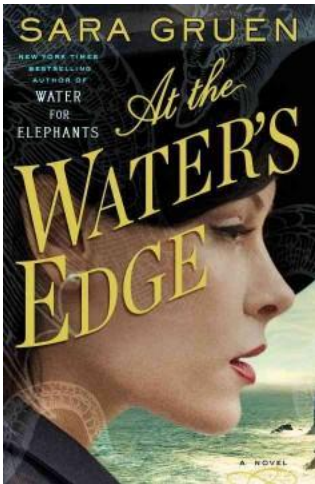
This is how you lose the time war

Two time-traveling agents from warring futures, working their way through the past, begin to exchange letters—and soon fall in love.



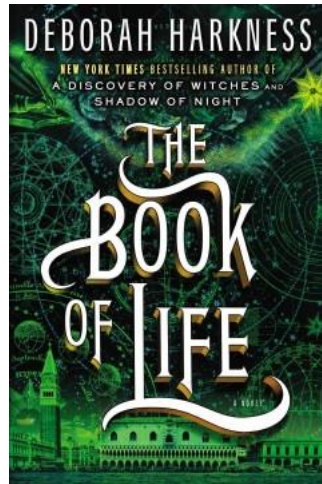
Jane in love

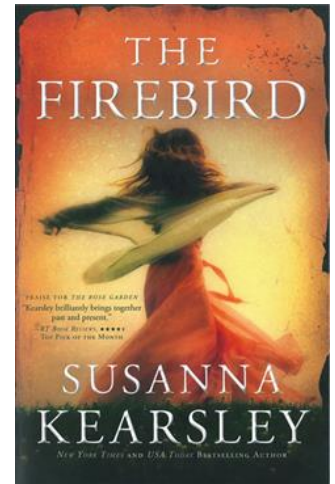
The book of life

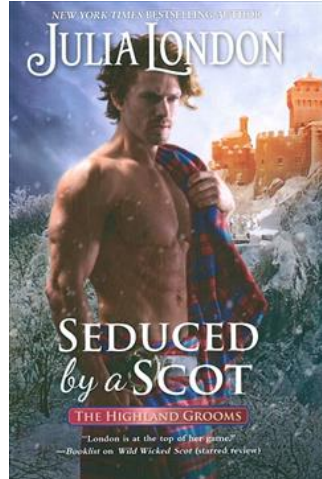
The firebird

A modern day woman with psychic abilities helps uncover the provenance of a small wooden carving, tracing it all the way back to eighteenth century Scotland and Russia.



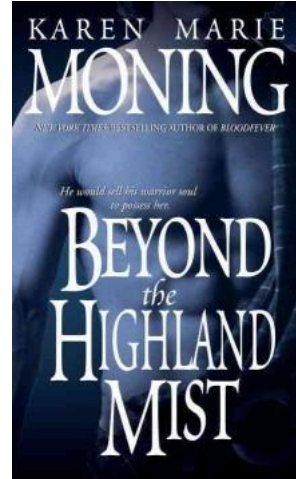
Ever my love

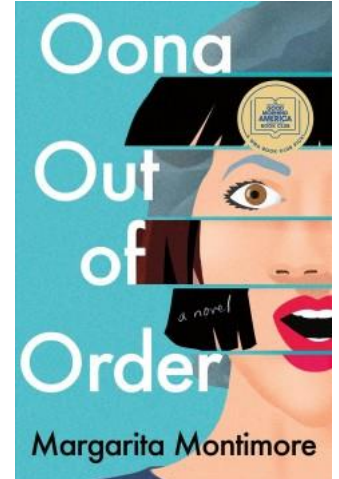
Seduced by a Scot

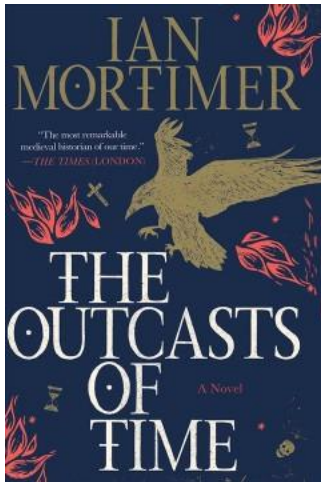
Beyond the Highland mist

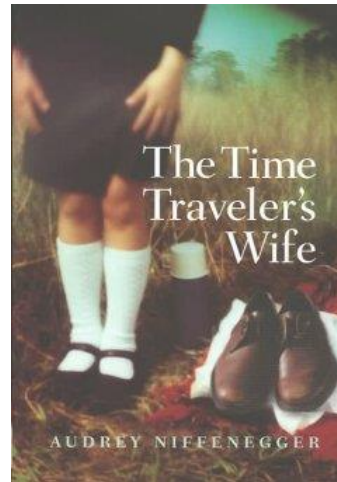
The outcasts of time

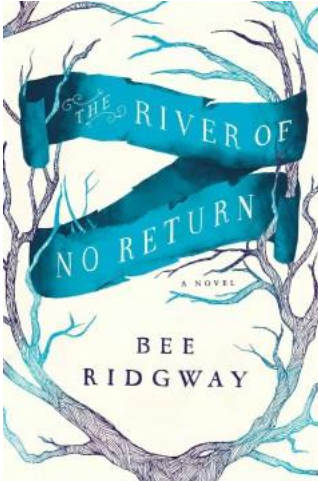
The time traveler's wife

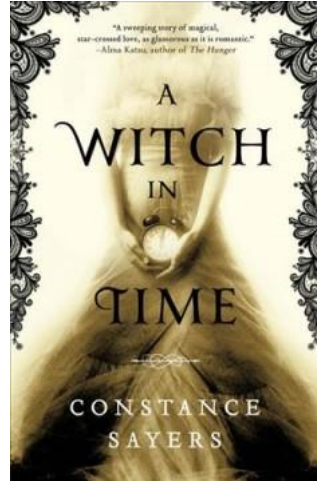
The Highland fling

An American searching for her purpose escapes to a Scottish town but finds more questions than answers when she meets a brooding yet handsome handyman.



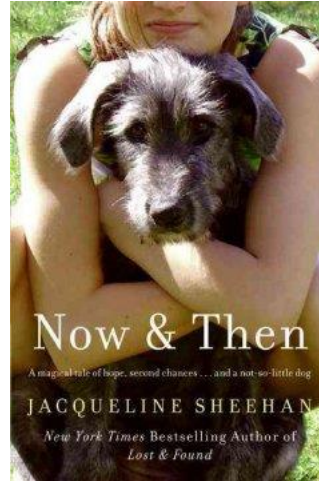
The river of no return

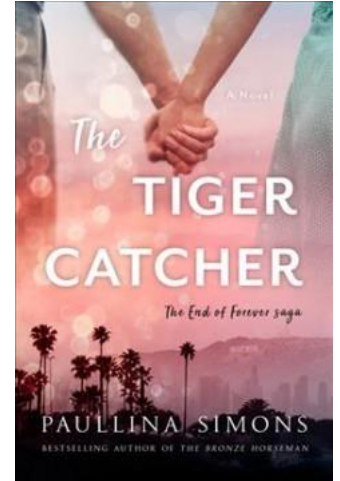
A witch in time

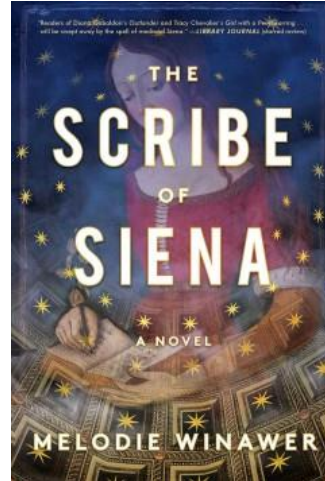
The tiger catcher
