# **2019 DONATIONS by MBE**

\$1000 San Mateo Mounted Patrol - for the Towne Creek Bridge at Jack Brooks (completed)

**\$500** CAPE (Center for Animal Protection and Education, Submitted by Kathy St. John

CAPE, located in Grass Valley, rescues horses who are older and have special needs. Currently there are 46 animals in their care, many who have come to live out their lives at the CAPE Animal Sanctuary. One equine in particular, Renegade, needed special help due to costs of medication, special diet, vet care and supplements to get him back on his feet and healthy.



\$1000 Pregnant Mare Rescue, Submitted by Ed Kilduff

The Pregnant Mare Rescue, located in Aptos, is a sanctuary dedicated to rehabilitating and re-homing abused and mistreated horses to forever dwellings where they will be genuinely

cherished and loved. Pregnant mares and orphaned foals from all over the nation are protected at Pregnant Mare Rescue. In almost thirteen years, PMR has rescued, rehabilitated and rehomed over 345 horses. In their care, the spirit of the horse is protected, alive and well.

**\$500** SPCA for Monterey County, submitted by Caroline Spicher The donation for the SPCA Monterey County will be specified for horse related care and treatment of rescued horses to go toward feed, vet bills, supplements, hoof care and dental, necessary for the recovery, health and adoption of these horses.

\$500 CanHam Farm Horse Rescue, submitted by Sheryl Germany
Located in Scotts Valley, CanHam Farm rescue is starting a new program "Horses Helping Humans" that is
intended to help people benefit from the therapeutic power of horses! The program will cater to those suffering
from anxiety, stress, addiction, recovery, difficult life circumstances, and adults and children with physical
disabilities or limitations such as Cerebral Palsy, Stroke and Head Injuries.

**\$2000** Backstretch Horse Rescue, submitted by Debra Means and Liz Riehl Located in Aromas, Backstretch Horse Rescue offers a safe haven for abandoned, abused or neglected horses, in addition to a variety of ways that the community can engage with these beautiful creatures. Donated funds will be used specifically for fencing, feeding and health care for the 43 horses that were rescued just this past year. You might remember the 9 starving Thoroughbreds that were rescued in Hollister this past year, which 1 required immediate surgery. Another 5 were rescued in Prunedale after their own passed away.
