

RANCH ADVENTURE OPTIONS 2025

Inclusive Rate Activity Package

One session of the following onsite guided adventure activities is included per day, per guest, in your overall price package. A second guided activity, or any a la carte activities, are at the rate listed per option. Please complete a Guest Reservation Form at least 30 days prior to arrival, to ensure that your chosen activity and equipment will be available. All activities are subject to weather and guide availability. Participation in additional activity sessions and a 20% gratuity/service fee will be billed at the conclusion of your visit. Guide activities are not typically available the day of arrival as check-in is after 2pm, or the day of departure as check-out is 11am.

SHOOTING SPORTS

Rifle, Pistol, Shotgun and Carbine: Learn how to accurately operate a variety of firearms at our unrivaled shooting venues. Our guides and instructors will provide a safe and fun learning experience for all members of your family or group. Firearm training available (choose one per session): Rifle, pistol, shotgun, carbine/AR. *Minimum age of 10 for rifle/shotgun, age 13+ for pistol shooting; minors under 18 years require parental supervision.* Rates include use of premium ranch firearms, instruction, and transport to shooting venues. Ammunition is additional cost and will be added to final bill. *Minimum of 2 participants per session.* NO EXPERIENCE NECESSARY TO PARTICIPATE. Difficulty level: easy to moderate. Duration: 2-4 hours, depending on guest comfort and progression.

• Additional session: \$295 per person, plus cost of ammunition used.

Sporting Clays: test your skills or enjoy some friendly competition with your group members at our covered Shooting Sports Pavilion. *Prior experience in firearms is required, or upgrade to our half-day shooting sports for personal instruction. Difficulty level: easy to moderate. Duration: 2 hours.*

• Additional Sessions: \$150 per round of 50 clays per person - includes shotgun use and 2 boxes (50 shot shells) of ammo.

Archery: learn to shoot a recurve bow on our Olympic Style range, and then progress to our 3-D archery course along Brush Creek. For maximum fun, try out our **Sporting Arrows** activity! Our guides provide safe and fun training for the whole family, ages 6+. *Difficulty level: easy to moderate. NO EXPERIENCE NECESSARY. Duration:* 1-3 hours, depending on guest comfort and progression.

• Additional Sessions: \$150 per person for 2-hour training session, or \$75 per person for Sporting Arrows shoot. Pricing includes all equipment and instruction, or archers are welcome to bring their equipment for the 3-D range.

EXPLORE & LEARN

Horseback Riding (*April-October*, *and as weather permits*): enjoy a relaxing trail ride through our scenic and wildlife-rich canyon on gentle ranch horses. Trail riders must have previous riding experience. Beginners can improve their riding skills in our arena before progressing to the trail. *Minimum age 10 for trail rides. Children ages 2-9 years can meet and ride horses in arena. Guests are recommended to wear cowboy boots or similar closed-toe*

shoes with heels or easy slip-on/off. Helmets will be provided for all riders. Rider weight limit 250 pounds. Maximum group size of 4 per session. Difficulty level: moderate. Duration: 2-3 hours for trail ride, 1 hour arena ride.

• Additional riding sessions, per rider: \$250 trail ride, \$125 arena

RANCH TOURS & WILDLIFE SAFARIS

Explore the backroads and two-tracks of the ranch in a comfortable jeep or UTV side-by-side, taking in the grandeur of the landscape and viewing wildlife in their natural habitat. Your guide will visit key points of historical interest and photographic opportunities.

- Canyon Tour: Approximately 3 hours, up to 3 guests plus guide per vehicle. Additional session \$225 per jeep/guide.
- Ranch Safari (additional cost): This is a full day excursion on the ranch, viewing wildlife and even participating in our land management program. Plan on an early start before sunrise and breakfast to go, a tail gate lunch on the mountain, and breathtaking views all day long! Bring your big lens if you are into wildlife photography. Approximately 6 hours, up to 3 guests per guide per vehicle: \$450/vehicle.

Golf: practice your swing and watch wildlife play on our beautiful golf driving range. Adult and youth clubs available, or bring your own. *Difficulty level: easy to moderate...depending on the golfer.*

• Additional sessions: \$75 per person includes bucket of 50 balls and golf equipment.

Fly Fishing Instruction

Our expert-level fly fishing guides will instruct beginners on the beautiful and enjoyable art of fly fishing, focusing on casting and gear setup. Experienced fishermen will improve their casting skills. Fish for rainbow and cut bow trout, tiger trout, large-mouth bass, bluegill, crappie, and channel catfish in our stocked private lakes. All gear is included, or bring your own. **No fishing license needed to fish our lakes.** *Difficulty level: easy to moderate. Minimum recommended age: 8 years.*

• Add an afternoon session (approx. 2 hours) of fly-tying for \$150 per person, includes all supplies.

Wine Tasting

Tantalize your senses with an exquisite selection of wines from our award-winning vineyards of La Follette, Quivira, and Torbreck. Several of our labels consistently score 91 or better. All tastings are paired with a delightful selection of hors d'oeuvres, prepared by our chef. Served on our patio, lakeside, or at our mountaintop gazebo, weather dependent. *Age requirement*: 21+

For The Kids

Children visiting the ranch with their families will have the opportunity to learn many new skills by participating with parental supervision in the activities listed above. We also offer fun kids crafts sessions, adventure hikes, and short excursions surrounding the lodge. Your child will benefit the most just being able to "unplug" and run wild, paddle the lake (lifejackets are provided), learn about the fish and wildlife living at the ranch, hear stories about the pioneers who settled the area, make s'mores over the campfire, and connect with nature. We do not offer a child-care program, we encourage children and parents to experience life-long memories together.

A LA CARTE ACTIVITIES

These activities can be added for the price listed, and as availability allows. These are activities which are either off-site or utilize third party vendors. Select these on your Guest Registration Form so that we can make reservations well in advance and ensure availability. These will be non-refundable once booked with the vendor.

JET BOAT TOURS on the COLORADO RIVER (seasonal, May 15-mid September):

Experience a thrilling tour of the Colorado River in a custom New Zealand style jet boat through breathtaking canyon scenery! Sit back and let the expert drivers show you the best hour you'll ever have on a river. Requires advance reservation. Up to 10 passengers per tour. Total session is approx. 2.5 hours including travel time from ranch to dock. *Ages* 5+. *Difficulty level: easy.*

• Rate: \$175 per person, or private tours for \$575 per hour (1-4 passengers), \$675 per hour (5+ passengers). Includes roundtrip shuttle from ranch to Jet Boat dock. *Guests will be given a safety briefing and sign waivers at time of arrival.*

SPA SERVICES

Massage Therapy – enjoy a relaxing massage in our tranquil spa. Requires 7 day advance reservations and minimum of two guests, or one 90 minute treatment. *Rate includes gratuity*.

• \$185 per 60 minute treatment, \$275 per 90 minute treatment.

"Pamper Package" - Manicure, Pedicure, Hair cut/style and other onsite spa services can be arranged based on personal or group request. Requires minimum 14 day advance notice, price TBD based on package requested.

LOCAL TOURING OPTIONS

• Local Excursions: 9-passenger Van & Driver for other local excursions or shopping: \$350 for ½ day (5 hours, with drive time), \$700 full day (maximum of 8 hours with drive time; includes lunch for driver)
