Precision Shooting Program - 2027 Courses Offerings

NOTE: all course dates listed here include the arrival and departure days. Participants should plan to arrive to the Lodge between 2-6pm on the arrival day, and depart the Lodge by 11am on departure day. Lunch is not served on arrival or departure days, please plan accordingly. Nearest airport with rental cars or ranch shuttle pickup is Grand Junction Regional (GJT).

**Participants must complete at least one of the following courses as pre-requisite for being added to the antlered big game hunt wait-list. Shooters who also complete the Elk Hunter Course are given higher preference.*

"PRECISION SHOOTER COURSE - Level 1":

Date Options: April 28-May 2, June 2-6, July 21-25 August 11-15

Rate: \$5,960.00 p/p

Length: 3 days, 4 nights

Course Overview: Primary objectives of this course include firearm system operation (rifle, optics, equipment), fundamentals of shooting and firearm selection, and application and continuance of your acquired skill sets. This course is for beginners just starting their shooting or hunting journey, or experienced shooters who want a refresher and new techniques to improve their skills and confidence. Shooters will complete the course with confidence in their ability to safely handle firearms, and to make an accurate shot in nearly any circumstance. Expect to shoot 200+ rounds between all ranges. *Price includes use of BRC suppressed precision firearm rental, and all field equipment. Ammunition purchase is additional, based on consumption. Maximum of 12 participants per event.*

"PRO-HUNTER COURSE - Level 2 ":

Date Options: May 19-23, June 16-20, July 28-August 1, August 18-22

Rate: \$5,660.00 p/p

Length: 3 days, 4 nights

Course Overview: This intensive course is the next step for our Level 1 graduates who want to advance their shooting skills or prepare for a specific upcoming hunting trip. Learn how to engage targets at steep angles, wind or adverse weather conditions, and in difficult terrain, utilizing Kestrels and other advanced technology to extend your maximum effective range. This course will also improve critical and realistic hunting skills, communicating with your guide or spotter, follow-up shots, and use of field gear to adapt and overcome improvised shooting positions. You will spend most of your time at our Steel Safari range ("Thunder Gap"), shooting at life-size wildlife targets in

real-world hunting situations. Shooters may bring their own personal rifles and optics systems or rent a rifle and purchase ammunition at the ranch. *If you have not taken our Level 1 course, but have completed a similar training course elsewhere, you may be eligible to upgrade to this course. Our instructors will make the decision prior to deposit being paid. Price does not include range rifle rental. If bringing personal firearm, your rifle must be capable of being suppressed. Maximum of 12 participants per event.*

"HUNTER PREP COURSE"

Date Options: July 15-18 and August 5-8

Rate: \$4,495.00 p/p

Length: 2 days, 3 nights

Course Overview: This is the next step for our Pro-Hunter Course graduates who want to refresh or advance their shooting and hunting skills, or for hunters or shooters prepare for a specific upcoming hunt or competition. Focus is on ensuring your equipment is properly setup and ready for use, dialing in your data, and getting comfortable in improvised shooting positions. Bring your full kit (gear) that you plan to take on your hunt. If you need help selecting the correct gear applicable to upcoming adventures, send us the recommended packing lists from your outfitters and we will assist you with selection and purchase of gear and firearm system. Maximum of 8 participants per event.

"ELK HUNTER COURSE":

Date options: November 17-22 and December 1-6

Rate: \$6,990.00 p/p

Length: 4 days, 5 nights

Course Overview: This course combines 1.5 days of intense Precision Shooter training with 2.5 days of hunting for cow elk. The hunt portion will be practical application of your coursework, as you and your professional guides venture afield in pursuit of cow elk. Guiding will be 2 hunters per guide. This is an excellent course if you are curious about hunting and how to get started. *Range firearm rental and gear included, or bring your own suppressor-capable rifle. Requires successful draw of cow elk license for GMU 31. License cost is extra. Deadline to book this course: March 30, 2027*

Experience level: *valid Hunter Education card from any state, Canadian Province, or foreign country, or a Colorado Apprentice Hunter Certificate is required for application in limited license draw. No other experience required. First time hunters sign up! We will assist with all applications & steps. Maximum of 6 participants with elk licenses, and up to 6 additional shooting-only course participants per event date.*

"THE GRADUATES" ELK HUNT:

Date Options: December 9-13, or December 16-20

Rate: \$5,925.00

Length: 3 days, 4 nights

Overview: this hunt is for graduates of our Elk Hunter Course who wish to return for continued hunting experiences at the ranch, or while wait-listed for antlered hunts. The hunt combines 1 day of intense shooting practice/review, and 2 full days of hunting for cow elk. Guiding will be 2 hunters per guide. Bring your own suppressed rifle, or rent as needed. *Requires successful draw of cow elk license for GMU 31. License cost is extra. Deadline to book this course: March 30, 2027. Maximum of 6 hunters per event date.*

PACKAGE RATES INCLUDE:

- Luxury private room accommodations, meals and refreshments, and all beverages (beer, house wine, spirits and all non-alcoholic options).
- Professional instructors, big game guiding services, and basic firearm cleaning supplies. In designated courses, use of premium suppressed ranch firearms are also included.
- Gratuity for Branded Rock Canyon ranch and lodge staff.
- Local sales tax of 3.9% on applicable items.

**Rates do not include:* ammunition for all courses, suppressed rifle rental for Level 2, Prep or Graduates courses (\$100/day), airport transfers or rental car, à la carte items and other guided activities, ProShop purchases, premium wine upgrades, tips for your shooting instructor and/or personal hunting guide, hunting license (approx. \$925 for non-residents, including application fees), game meat processing, taxidermy. Roundtrip Grand Junction Regional Airport (GJT) shuttle service can be requested at \$250 per shuttle vehicle, between the hours of 8am-6pm. After-hours shuttle incurs over-time charge of \$150. Colorado Firearms Excise tax of 6.5% is charged on all sales of firearms and precursor parts, ammunition, and suppressors, in addition to local sales tax of 3.9%. It is not charged on rental fees.

MORE OPTIONS:

Observers: Add an observer to any course, sharing room with primary shooting participant: \$400 per person per night (includes tax & gratuity). Most rooms feature two queen beds. Or upgrade to a King Suite on request for additional charge. Guided activity options are available to observers for additional charge, and depending on season/weather: *Please review our [Ranch Adventure Options](#) for more information.*

Additional shooting course participant, sharing room with primary: 30% off course rate for over 21 years of age, 50% off course rate for under 21. Minimum participant age is 12. Youth participants must attend course with parent/guardian. Discounts are not applicable to the Elk Hunter or Graduates Courses.

Pro-Package Upgrade: Add a custom or premium firearm from our ProShop and become proficient with your own firearm. Requires 4 month advance notice, and passing federal firearms background check. Pricing on request (P.O.R)

Private Instruction: If you prefer a personalized experience, book your own private or corporate group shooting course. Please contact us for details and dates. Inquire well in advance! P.O.R.

RESERVATION & CANCELLATION POLICY

- DEPOSITS: A 50% deposit is required to secure reservation. Balance is due 60 days before course start. You will receive further information and Guest Registration Forms at that time.
- CANCELLATIONS: Cancellations by client forfeit all payments made. However, 50% of total deposit may be applied to another course or an alternate student within 1 year, subject to availability. All requests to transfer to alternate course or student must be approved in writing by management no later than 60 days prior to course start date, or deposit is forfeited. Future rates will apply.
