

Precision Shooting Program - 2023 Courses & Rates

"PRECISION HUNTER COURSE":

Dates: April 27-May 1 or June 1-5

Rate: \$5,500.00 p/p Length: 3 days, 4 nights

Course Overview: This course is perfect for the complete beginner, or the experienced hunter or shooter who wants a refresher and new techniques to apply to their upcoming hunt. After a classroom portion to review the groundwork of ballistics and rifle systems, we move to our "Zero Range" for instruction out to 1,200 yards. Every day you will progress to a different range location where you learn how to overcome the many challenges involved in hunting and shooting in the mountains. We will push the limits to your maximum ethical distance but concentrate on first round hits on life-sized wildlife targets. Our small class sizes allow for maximum individual attention, and shooters will complete the course with confidence in their ability to make a successful shot in nearly any circumstance. *Price includes use of BRC precision firearms, and all field equipment*.

"LADIES-ONLY COURSE"

Date: August 10-14 Rate: \$5,800.00 p/p Length: 3 days, 4 nights

Course Overview: No experience needed! Ladies, this is the perfect opportunity to learn the basics of shooting, while in a comfortable setting and in the company of other adventurous women. You will acquire the skills and confidence to accurately shoot rifle, pistol, and shotgun or carbine. We instruct this course in a way that is extremely fun, educational, and safe. Spend your mornings in firearm training, and your afternoons being pampered in our spa, enjoying fine wines, fishing our lakes, or enjoying other on-site activities. Come away from this course with confidence in firearm handling and safety, and the ability to protect, defend, and hunt. Price includes use of BRC firearms, gear, and several afternoon program activities. Observers are welcome to visit the ranch for R&R and other activities while the ladies participate in the course. Observer rates apply.

"PRO-HUNTER COURSE":

Date: August 3-7 or August 17-21

Rate: \$5,280.00 p/p Length: 3 days, 4 nights

Course Overview: This is the next step for our Precision Hunter Course graduates who want to advance their shooting and hunting skills or prepare for a specific upcoming hunting trip. This course will cover aspects of hunting which include observation, tracking, concealment and movement skills, and planning the hunt. You will learn how to engage targets in low light, moving targets, steep angles, and extend your maximum shooting distance all while becoming proficient in reading your environment. You will be faced with challenging shoot/don't shoot scenarios, engraining into you the ability to make the critical and quick decision between making a successful ethical shot and making a mistake. Shooters may bring their own personal rifles and optics system or rent a rifle and purchase ammunition at the ranch. If you have not taken our Precision Hunter Course, but have completed a similar training course elsewhere, you may be eligible to upgrade to this course. Our instructors will make the decision prior to deposit being paid. Price does not include range rifle rental.

"PRECISION ELK HUNTER COURSE":

Date options: October 21-26, December 4-9, December 11-16

Rate: \$6,980.00 p/p Length: 4 days, 5 nights

Course Overview: This course combines 1.5 days of our Precision Hunter Course with 2.5 days of hunting for cow elk at Branded Rock Canyon ranch. The course starts with a classroom portion to review the groundwork of ballistics and rifle systems, and then progresses to our "Zero Range" for instruction out to 600 yards. We will push the limits to your maximum ethical distance, but concentrate on first round hits on realistic-sized wildlife targets. The hunt portion will be practical application of your coursework, as you and your professional guides venture afield in pursuit of cow elk. Guiding will be 2x1, with a maximum course size of 6 hunters. Range firearm rental and gear included. Requires successful draw of cow elk license in general application, secondary draw, or purchase of leftover tag (if available) for Colorado GMU 31 (\$772.50 plus application fees for non-residents). Experience level: valid Hunter Education card or Apprentice Hunter Certificate is required for purchase of Colorado elk tag. No other experience required.

MORE OPTIONS

Observers: Add an observer to any course, sharing room: \$350 per night p/p plus tax, or separate room \$750 p/p per night plus tax, as availability allows.

Activity options available for observers: R&R in one of the most beautiful lodge settings in the world, cooking course with our world-class chef, wine tasting, spa & massage treatments, horseback riding, ranch tours, fishing, local area shopping and touring. Guided a la carte activity rates apply and some activities are seasonal. Please review our Ranch Adventure Options for more information.

<u>Presidential Package Upgrade:</u> Add a custom or premium firearm from our ProShop, plus 200 rounds of precision-grade ammunition to any package. Become proficient with your own firearm! Requires 4 month advance notice. P.O.R.

<u>Private Instruction:</u> We offer exclusive-use of the lodge and property for private lessons or corporate group shooting course. Any of the above-listed courses can be booked as the group activity for a private or corporate retreat. Exclusive course booking requires paying for a minimum of 6 seats, and is based on date availability. Please contact us for details. Make your reservations well in advance! P.O.R.

PACKAGE RATES INCLUDE:

- Luxury private room accommodations, meals and refreshments, and beverages (beer, house wine, spirits and all non-alcoholic options).
- Professional instruction by expert shooters, hunting guides, and basic firearm cleaning supplies. In designated courses, use of premium ranch firearms are also included.
- Round trip airport shuttle from Grand Junction Regional Airport (GJT) for flights arriving/departing between the hours of 9am-5pm. Additional charges apply for after-hours shuttles. Guests are welcome to rent a vehicle for more flexible travel.
- Gratuity for Branded Rock Canyon ranch and lodge staff.
- Local taxes on applicable items

*Rates do not include: ammunition for all courses, rifle rental on ProHunter Course (\$75/day), à la carte items and guided activities, purchases made in our retail ProShop, premium wine upgrades, tips for your shooting instructor or personal hunting guide.

RESERVATION & CANCELLATION POLICY

- DEPOSITS: A 50% deposit is required to secure reservation. Balance is due at conclusion of course.
- CANCELLATIONS: Cancellations by client forfeit all payments made. However, 50% of total deposit may be applied to another course or an alternate student within 1 year, subject to availability. All requests to transfer to alternate course or student must be approved in writing by management no later than 60 days prior to course start date, or deposit is forfeited. Future rates will apply. Private courses require a 50% non-refundable, non-transferable deposit of 6 seats minimum.
 - Should Branded Rock Canyon need to cancel or reschedule a course, your deposit will be transferred to another course date or refunded.
