What does this Program Offer?

- Implements inductive Bible study methods and teaches students to investigate the Bible in depth as well as looking at practical issues such as apologetics, career planning, marriage, etc.
- Includes a large core of prescribed courses with an emphasis on college preparation in the belief that all students should be literate in and conversant with the humanities, the sciences, and the arts.
- Requires that all students study math and science throughout high school in order to help them be better prepared to address the pressing scientific and technological issues of the next millennium.
- Offers three tracks: general, college preparatory, and honors. This allows individualization according to a student's talents and abilities. (See reverse side)
- Teaches that history is really "His" story. Students see the historical development of theology, art, ethics, economics, and literature while studying the rich heritage of western civilization and American history with the Biblical integration of God's principles of life.
- Introduces students to serious language study. They receive two to three years of Spanish in high school.
