

New York golf courses are allowed to remain open but must implement all CDC and state mandated guidelines, and promote safe, social distancing. There is to be no access to pro shops, locker rooms, indoor facilities and restaurants/bars (unless for take-out purposes only).

### Social distancing on the golf course should include:


- Stay at least 6 feet away from others


Holes4Hereos was a terrific topic of conversation with many thinking it's a great idea and hope to make it out. We're just worried about the date now.

The golf expo in Cobleskill scheduled for late March was cancelled.




### A TALE OF REVENGE
