### Covid-19, Tavern 1897, and SGC

As of this writing, the current Covid-19 mandates require a mask to be correctly worn at all times on our deck, and inside the Golf Shop and Clubhouse, unless seated. Social distancing of at least 6' apart is also required of all tables. We ask our golfers to walk around the back of clubhouse to sign in, grab, and return carts.

Our carts are washed and sanitized throughout the day. One rider per cart, unless you are members of the same household, and/or have quarantined together.

Alcoholic beverages can not be served without a food order. Tavern 1897 has some special, low cost options for you to choose from. There is no standing allowed at the bar and seated patrons at the bar must remain at least 6' apart.

We may not agree with all of these mandates, but we do agree that they must be followed to maintain a safe atmosphere for our members, guests, and staff. We appreciate your understanding of these mandates, and your willingness to help us provide a safe dining experience.

Also, our deck is a "No Smoking Area". Smokers should be at least 50' off the deck.






