All you need is your GHIN number, which we have here at the Pro Shop. Simply go to ghin.com on your home computer or download the free mobile app to your smart phone from the app store.

Then post your score right after you play. It's as easy as that! This will help prevent posting errors, missed scores, and duplicates that occur when turning cards in. SGC is one of over 14,000 golf clubs that use the GHIN handicapping system. Please see me and I would be happy to provide you with any information to get started!



Also called a 'triple-eagle' or double-albatross' in the US.

#### **Greens & Grounds**

Well where did June go? What a month, snow, frost delays, heat, no rain, high winds ...well, we made it. The chemicals that were applied like the wetting agent will keep the moisture in the greens longer. Also there are no diseases on the greens from a steady flow of fungicides which is always a good sign. Greens were verti-cut and lightly top dressed, which has brought a smoother roll to putts. We hope to do this again in July and August.

Bunkers are done and are no longer considered "ground under repair". The old trap on the left of the 8th green is no longer; it is ground under repair until fully repaired. Bunkers are being raked every morning for your convenience. We are still awaiting permission to put out rakes, ball washers or coolers. Until then we will be focused on making your experience as comfortable as we can.

The tall fescue areas have been well received by the vast majority of members and greens fee-ers. The course is in great shape; the crew and I hope to see you out and about enjoying a round. Till next month...
