The year was 1976 and I just got my first invite to the Invitational. Up to Stamford I go with several friends and checked into the Red Carpet. What a great weekend of golf and partying. I went on to play in the next 40 Invitationals. During those years I made several close friendships. I remember running up to the course on Friday nights to play in the animal game and then play cards all night until teeing off on Saturday. What a blast! My wife and I built a house in Stamford and had great times. I was a member of the club for all those years and even served on the board. I remember golf being accessible every day 7 days a week. My son took up golf and spent long hours on the range while I did security at the bar. On any given weekend there might be 10 to 20 people in the clubhouse. When my son Pete had his first hole-in-one on number 3 at 14 years old it was on Father's Day so 80 people in the bar. \$200 bill. A few years later I had a hole-in-one on 8. That was during the invitational. \$300 bill. The invitational has had some good years and lean years but it's back! I now watch my son and his friends play in that tournament every year. They love it as much as my crew loved it. Thanks to all for making my life full of great memories and Play Well!
