

s we set out to begin another show season in Branson our 66th Baldknobbers' season to be exact—I feel it only fair to pay homage to the two months each year that allow us to refresh and re-engage. January and February—known by the entertainment community as "offseason"—provides just enough time to take a breath, escape the stage lights and remind ourselves why we do what we do.

Off-season is sacred. Essential. Special. It's the chance to step outside the fences of a show schedule and play "normal". We take trips. We watch prime-time television. We catch our kids' games and activities. We experiment just long enough in the nine-to-five world that by the time March rolls around, we are ready to jump back into the creative crazy of show business. It's where we belong.

While we pack as much "everyday" into off-season as we possibly can, we also sprinkle in performance opportunities that we aren't able to fit in while doing a full show schedule. Throughout the past two months, my husband and I have performed in nursing homes, on a cruise ship and across multiple states for various special events. We have performed from Florida to the Bahamas to Philadelphia. A lot of driving, a lot of flying and a lot of "aha" moments.

performances. I have been reminded firsthand that music truly is universal. It's a cliche statement, but it couldn't

have shown itself to me more clearly than throughout the past several weeks. I've been left with a heightened awareness that, while easy to forget while in the grind of a show season, what we do comes with a responsibility. God has given us entertainers talents that provide a service to our audience members. and we need to take our job seriously.

Music brings a collective joy. It bonds people. It is a common language. Music is healing. It is therapeutic.

Music can be quite miraculous. While we were performing for nursing homes last month, I watched an Alzheimer's unit transform after iust one hour of music. When we arrived, the room was quiet and unresponsive. The residents were having dinner, and quite frankly, I don't think they were eager for our interruption. There was no conversation, and the sound of scraping utensils was deafening. Melancholy covered the room.

Oh, but what music can do! By the time we left, there was new life. The residents started singing and clapping. One resident, despite normally relying on her walker, started dancing. The nurse informed us afterward that she had not stood unassisted or been that responsive in weeks. A whole group of individuals strugaling to remember pieces of daily life found the familiar in music. They found the joy. They may not have been able to tell me what day




the Mom in the group), also began her career as a child singing in church, (located in a small Louisiana town just a few miles from young Robert's.)


Like Robert, Leisa's talent and her love for singing never stopped.
