



Going on a trip to Mexico to help provide wheelchairs for paraplegic children was certainly something Brandon and Megan Mabe were looking forward to, but for these two stars of Branson's Famous Baldknobbers Show, the timing couldn't have been worse.

It was only a matter of a few weeks, if not days, that Branson's 2023 show season was about to kick off—and for the Mabes, that involved "to-do" lists that could stretch for miles! There

were costumes to deal with, lighting issues, rehearsals that needed to be scheduled, new songs and comedy bits to work on—all creating mountains of details that could cause stress levels to reach near volcanic proportions!

But commitments had been made and this star duo was not going to back out. Even so, during the long flight to Mexico, Megan was hard at work on the Internet frantically shopping to fulfill costuming demands, while beside her, Brandon was pounding the keys of his own laptop as he worked on the show and tried to manage The Branson Famous Theatre. But little did these stars know, all those things were about to change; for upon their arrival in Mexico they would be fast swept into a whole new world. Costumes, the show, the theaternone of that would ever be so much as mentioned or even thought much about for the next several days, for this was truly another world.

## **Another World**

A first it didn't seem like another world, for arriving in Mexico's beautiful city of Cabo San Lucas at the Southern tip of the country's Baja peninsula was not unfamiliar territory to Branson's star couple. They had vacationed here before during their show's short off-season and had loved this resort town located between the Pacific Ocean and Mexico's Gulf of California. in a former school, which now had become an outreach for the Mexican state's paralyzed children.

At this location, charitable outreaches converged. Charities **Mobilize Mankind** teamed up with **Hope Haven** and **Branson Cares** to provide wheelchairs here, although the wheelchairs needed to be assembled and customized to fit each individual child.

## **Life Changing**

Branson visitors this season will take note of the fund raising displays of Branson Cares and their program's partner Hope Haven, which are appearing in several of the town's theater lobbies. The charity raises money to provide wheelchairs for paraplegic children throughout the world. Branson Cares was organized by Branson Entertainer Bob Nichols, the founder and director of BAAM (Branson Academy for the Advancement of Music

and Theater), whose board of directors include Brandon. "Branson Cares is s a great program," Brandon tells *The Insider*. "It really does reach out. A lot of people don't realize there's such a strong need for these wheelchairs all over the world. But this trip really opened our eyes to how important this cause really is. We just thought we'd go, help put together these wheelchairs and distribute them to kids in need. But it turned out to be more than we ever thought it would be. It actually became an experience that I'd have to say, for me, was life changing."

literally carrying them everywhere they go."

"Obviously, these wheelchairs benefit the child," says Megan. "There's no cost, and it's life-changing. You take a child who has never sat up in their life, and suddenly, *they're sitting up!* Imagine what a different

view of the world a child can get just by something as simple as a chair. But then it changes a parent's life too because suddenly, they have a way to move the child, to take the child outside. Now, the child may get to go to school. Now the parent can put the child in the chair, go cook dinner and know the child is safe and secure—or they can even bring the child in the kitchen while they're cooking. It's really life changing, and it all happens



with something as simple as a chair with two wheels. You just don't realize what an impact that can make."

Says Brandon, "We heard of one family who was finally able to go to an outside barbecue without holding their child the

The process began by assigning parties of two to assemble each wheelchair; one of those twosome's obviously being Brandon and Megan. "I'm mediocre handy," Brandon confesses.

"I'm not handy at all," Megan adds. "But I improved."

"She did great," says Brandon. "What we ended up doing, I would build the frame, she'd build the seat, we'd assemble it together, then we'd work together until we'd get it to be a fit for one of the children."

One of those children was a young boy named Ignacio. "He had these big, brown eyes," Branson tells us. "They were just attached to Megan the entire time. We walked in there and some of these kids are just laying on a table, basically stuck in a certain position all tied up."

Says Megan, "I thought his limbs were immovable just because he'd never had a wheelchair, but I learned that when the child lays in these positions for so long immobility becomes permanent. A wheelchair can't change that, but it can keep it from getting worse." entire time. Being there without the family of the family, more included in what they did. The parents said they finally felt they had more freedom to mingle and communicate with others. So it's not just a healing for the kids, it's a healing for the parents too. A healing for the whole family."

## **No Words**

For these Americanos, there was obviously a language barrier when trying to

interact with the local parents and children. "You would try to make connections with these parents and children," Brandon relates. "But there was of course a communications gap. We don't know how to speak Spanish very fluently at all. We can understand words, short phrases, but we couldn't speak enough to have a conversation with them, so you communicated more with body language, with hand singles or whatever. Not to get overly sentimental or cliché, but it was more of a spiritual connection we were having with these kids and families. Not much verbal communication was going to happen."

Megan chimed in, revealing more about the child Ignacio. "It was like we were having a conversation just by looking at each other's eyes! In his eyes you could see his appreciation, his excitement about just having this whole new world in front of him. Yes, we were having an unspoken conversation, but it was far deeper of a conversation than any normal one with words. It was like perceiving that you were changing this person's life and you could see their appreciation coming back to you. And you knew the parents were appreciating you whether you could understand what they were saying or not."

"But they would tear up, "says Brandon." Or they would be laughing with us. You know there was one time I was bending down to

adjust one boy's wheelchair for him and all holding them made the child feel more part of a sudden he starts rubbing the top of my head."

#### "He really liked Brandon," says Megan.

'Of course my head was shaved more bald in Mexico, but he just kept rubbing my head, rubbing my head, and while I was working I just said as I was laughing, 'you just rub as long as you want'—so he just kept doin' it, doin' it. Then lo and behold the little kid bends down and

starts kissing me on the head! I think there was a level of appreciation, again, that these children were communicating to us because they're happy. They feel like they suddenly have that ability to be mobile. We're helping that. They're acknowledging that. And they're thankful for that. Megan had a spiritual connection with Ignacio through eye contact—I had one by a kid rubbin' and kissin' my head!"

## **Beyond our Imagination**

II t makes you realize how little you're actually doing, says Megan, "and how much more you *could* do! It helps to see how good we have it. You see this tremendous need and you see these people from these organizations who are giving so much of themselves freely, expecting nothing in return, and you realize, I can do more! And I feel ignorant. I went on this trip assuming there can't be that many children who need wheelchairs in Mexico—but the fact is there are hundreds and thousands of kids who need these things and there

are people who are willing to dedicate their lives to meeting those needs! We met a couple who used to help raise money for children with pediatric cancer and heart disease. They told us how people are so willing to give hundreds and thousands of dollars for those causes, but when raising money for wheelchairs, it's different. Donations

are small, usually coming in the form of \$5 or \$10 dollar bills. The reason being that most people think, well, it's just a wheelchair. It can't be that big of a deal. They don't realize the impact a wheelchair has, myself included, until I saw it with my own eyes! I discovered that wheelchairs are just as big of a need as helping with cancer or heart disease. These kids can't move, they can't live life, they can't go to school-their parents can't live normal lives—"

## **Painting a Picture**

Brandon does that by chiming in; (which The Branson Insider allows), "Imagine your kids growing up like that and you had no way to afford it, no way to get the resources you would need to put them in a wheelchair and get them mobile—and you had to witness your child going through that without knowing what to do. And they're just laying on the couch all day long. All they can do is just look around the room

with nothing else to do. The impact of having the ability to be mobile is lifechanging. We got to witness that on a very small level."

"I have four kids. You couldn't help but put yourself in their shoes for a second, thinking, oh my goodness, how blessed am I that I have four children who can run, play, communicate without the need of that wheelchair! And these kids just want to have a wheelchair! I mean, the pain that they must be in, laying in those positions all the time! A wheelchair gives them the support they need to hopefully eliminate or at

least limit the intensity of that pain. It gives them comfort. So you're helping these people on just so many levels! They don't have the medical care we have here. So the things we complain about here are starting to feel unreal to me. This experience has been a reality check for us in a lot of ways.

## The Challenge

Megan quickly seconds that emotion. "I just feel like I will never look at a wheelchair the same again. These kids don't have the access to wheelchairs like we do back home. Some

someone with a future. All because they don't have something as simple as a chair with two wheels on it. But we can do more. We don't know how little we understand the needs of others until those needs are right in our faces, so yeah, I realize now that I'm not doing nearly enough. I sometimes take things for granted. All these kids want is something with two wheels and a seatbelt. I believe God gives you experiences like this at times you need them most. They can remind you of your own blessings. That's what they did for us."

## The Experience of a Lifetime

ife is essentially a continuous merrygo-round of experiences. Some we circle back to often—the mundane; the everyday. Expected and predictable, these experiences can become a blur in the spin. Some however, leave an imprint that transcends the constant motion. They can have you wishing you could jump off the merry-go-round and dig your feet in, forcing it to stop so you can truly take in the beauty.

A few weeks ago, I had one of those experiences, and it was magical.

My husband and I had the opportunity to travel to La Paz, Mexico with Branson's Music and Theater Industry Organization—BAAMT— (Branson Academy for the Advancement of Music and Theatre) and a program called Branson Cares. Partnered with Hope Haven International Ministries, Branson Cares provides pediatric wheelchairs for children in need of mobility around the world. Brandon and I had the unique privilege to help in the building and distributing of these wheelchairs. That statement sounds very simple, but there was nothing simple about our experience.

When I found out we would be traveling to Mexico for this cause, I really had no idea what to expect. I assumed it would be a rewarding experience. I assumed I would meet special children and receive some sort of blessed fulfillment. I was not prepared, however, for the spiritual experience that was to come. In one week, I witnessed more about the human capacity to love and accept love than I have witnessed in my life's entirety.

The children we met were non-verbal. They did not have the ability to communicate, but the conversations we had were deeper than any spoken conversation. These children were able to speak with their eyes in a way that was truly angelic. I could see the love and the thankfulness each one felt as we fitted his or her chair. We were able to watch as some of these children sat in an upright position for the very first time. They could suddenly see the world through a "normal" lens—something we take for granted. No longer forgotten, they were now truly a present person. Something as

simple as a seat with two wheels changed a life in minutes.

It changed mine forever.

The highlight of my experience was having the opportunity to work with a young boy named Egnacio. He was unable to move or communicate. His father has carried him everywhere his entire life. When he was placed on the examination table, I realized how fragile and weak his small body had become from living a life without the mobilizing benefits of a wheelchair. His arms were permanently stuck in positions that seemed unbearable. He was so innocent. Asking for nothing, but needing so much.

When we positioned Egnacio in his chair for the first time, he locked eyes with me. I am not embarrassed to say it was a spiritual experience. It was a God thing. This child trusted me-a complete stranger—to buckle his seat belt, lift his head and position his arms. He, along with his family, allowed me into the most private and sacred parts of his world. I received a glimpse of his life, of his struggles, and of the faith he and his family share. I know nothing about disabilities or the proper handling and positioning of a disabled child. Yet, I was met only with thankful and loving eyes.

What a gift he gave me.

The moment Egnacio was upright in that chair, he was no longer fragile. He was no longer weak. He was a little boy who finally had the opportunity to live and see the world. The opportunity to be seen as more than a disability. His eyes expressed an appreciation beyond thanks. His eyes expressed a peace that only God's love can provide.

An angel perhaps?

God may tell me someday.

## **OUR INTERVIEW WITH JERRY**

**Us:** ("Us" meaning us at The Branson Insider) Whadja think about the Elvis movie, Jerry?

Jerry: I thought the movie was really well done. The actors in it were good. One part I did like is that it showed the true colors of The Colonel—the kind of person he was. There were some things left out of the movie that could have been put in, but overall, I think the kid did a great job doing the Elvis part. But I couldn't understand why they had **Tom** Hanks talking like he did with that accent because The Colonel didn't talk like that.

**Us:** He didn't have a Dutch accent?

**Jerry:** No. But he was just a gruff, old, mean guy.

#### Us: Did you ever see him?

**Jerry:** Oh yeah. In fact, back in 1971 he sent me a "Cease and Desist" letter. The letter said, *"If we find you trying to make it off the name of Presley, we will bring legal*


action against you!" So, I was just a kid, scared to death! I was only 21. But I got to thinking about it, so I went to an attorney and asked him, Can he do that? He said, "Son, what's your last name?" I said "Presley.""Well then," he says to me, "Watcha got to worry about? He can't sue you for usin' your own name, can he?" No sir, I don't guess he can. You tell me. "No, he said. He can't. You're good." Since then I never quit performing Elvis.

#### **Us:** Did you ever tell Elvis about that?

Jerry: Yes. Absolutely.

**Us:** What did Elvis say?

Jerry: Oh, he had a comment—maybe something like 'oh, you know, the old codger.' But yeah, that happened. I was out at Las Vegas one time. As I was walking along I hear this gruff old man yelling "Get out of the way, I'm comin' through!" It was the Colonel. He was in his wheelchair going through the crowd—just mean, bumpin into people, hollerin' at 'em. That was the Colonel. He wasn't a nice guy. I got on the

elevator with him and had some sort of short conversation.

**Us:** Did he know who you were?

**Jerry:** Probably not. I would always introduce myself to him. I didn't expect those people to know me or remember me like I was there every day. He wasn't very well liked by a lot of people, but he was good at his job. He was a promoter.

**Us:** And he promoted Elvis to the stratosphere.

**Jerry:** Well, yeah but a lot of people wonder, what if Elvis would have made it anyway? Who knows? We don't know. Elvis had the talent and the looks, but that style of talent and looks was unheard of. The Colonel was making 50% of what Elvis made. Nobody makes 50% percent. Nobody. But Elvis always stayed true to his word. Actually, the Colonel was making more than 50%. He owned a company that made all the Elvis memorabilia stuff, so he was getting all that. He gave a percentage to Elvis but he was making more than Elvis. They say that when it all boiled down, because of his marketing materials and stuff the Colonel was making 67% of what Elvis was making!

**Us:** What did he do with all that money?

**Jerry:** He gambled it away. So he died broke. H probably did a lot to make Vegas flourish.

**Us:** The earth shook when Elvis's daughter Lisa Marie Presley passed away recently. Did you ever meet her?

**Jerry:** Oh yeah. Well, the only thing I can say is the last time I saw her—I think it was around 2017, we were in Memphis and we were having this event. I can't remember what it was called, but Lisa was there and a lot of dignitaries like the actor **Morgan Freeman**. I got to talking with him. We talked for about a half hour. What amazed me was the way this guy was. When you saw him and his personality in the movies, *that* was Morgan Freeman! He acted and talked just like that in real life! That was just him! He was just a great person to talk to. Very interesting.

So anyway, after the event was over we walked outside. I was standing there and talking to some folks. About that time, Lisa was comin' out—so we said "Hi" to her, shook hands and stuff, then I went toward this door to go back into

the building. I was waiting for the lady I was with, so I'm standing there and the lady who was with me was talking and having a conversation with somebody. I saw Lisa get into her suburban,

Jerry Presley, as Elvis.

then while I'm standing there, I see her roll down

the window. Then I see she just stares at me. I couldn't really see her very well—I didn't know if she was pointing at me, or telling me to come in or what. About that time, she waved "Bye" at me and then drove off. I don't know why she was staring at me. But that was the last time I saw her.

Heartfelt tributes to Lisa Marie appeared on the marquee of Jerry Presley's God and Country Theater throughout the week she left us, which was all too soon. Elvis's love for God and his family was known by all who knew Him. As for their heavenly family reunion—we can only imagine.

Modern studies of lemurs did not begin in earnest until the 1950s and 1960s. Initially hindered by political issues on Madagascar during the mid-1970s, field studies resumed in the 1980s.

Many lemur species have already gone extinct in the last 2000 years due to human activity. Because of these threats and their declining numbers, environmentalist groups consider lemurs to be the world's most endangered mammals, noting that as of 2013 up to 90% of all lemur species confront the threat of extinction in the wild within the next 20 to 25 years. Many efforts try to preserve lemur habitats as well as promote public awareness and appreciation for lemurs.


