hen Karen's young life succumbed to the effects of anorexia nervosa at the tender age of 33, the world was shocked. Until then, the eating disorder, (anorexic) was largely unheard of among the general public. But that was then and this is now. It was the tragic loss of Karen Carpenter that educated us all. 




