

Due to his love for the music industry and his love for Branson, Mr. Beene, (who today lives way down yonder in Georgia), eventually brought the industry event to us here in Branson and re-named it The Branson Terry Music Awards! Lucky us! And with that big move came Terry's big agenda—to raise money for

As for Terry's love for the music industry, that's no joke. Besides spending four years in the United **States Navy**, he also spent several years as a professional drummer, traveling America and drumming for the likes of Jerry Lee Lewis, Tammy Wynette, Faron Young and even our own Barbara Fairchild, (just to name a few!) But then things started to take a turn for the worse. Fortunately, however, the sad story of that turn resulted in a transformed life that Terry celebrates today wherever he goes. It's even celebrated on the cover of the Branson Terry Awards program handed out to all attendees. Then, several years of it were spent traveling the world as a drummer for some of the biggest names in the world of country music, which later led to years of being a legendary record producer, disc jockey and TV show host in Fort Worth, Texas. It was at that point when famously, as we learned back on page 10—he began The Terry Awards as a joke.

But in the midst of it all, was the bad news hinted at in the previous part of this story. Drugs caused Terry's life to spiral into addiction.

The breaking point was when a friend driving a tour bus in the middle of the night spotted him wandering along a Texas freeway, an event Terry doesn't even remember. "It was a God thing, "Terry tells us.

But it was one that landed him in rehab, where he ended up living for an entire year. "For some Godly reason, God was lookin' after me" says Terry.

Fortunately, he came out of rehab, even though many of his friends did not, their lives being snuffed out due to the devastation of their addictions. Terry's life had been on its way to a similar sad ending, yet in contrast, his life suddenly became an absolute joy ride! The title of his speaking engagements is the big clue—"From Drugs to Jesus."

Although living in Georgia, his love for country music and for people who need the love of God brought him to Branson to continue The Terry Awards, this time for a completely different reason—to raise money for charity.

As Terry tells *The Insider,* "We're not doin' it for the money, we're doin' it out of love for people in need."


