MBERING A SHOJI TABUCHI April 16, 1944—August 11, 2023

Branson nation mourns the recent loss of one of its own—legendary Branson entertainer Shoji Tabuchi. Surrounded by his close-kinit, loving family, Shoji left us on August 11 after a recent illness. He was 79.

Shoji is remembered by generations of his fans for his spectacular Branson shows, his brilliant musicianship, showmanship and for the kindness, humility and gratitude he always expressed both toward his fans, and for his adopted homeland. His every audience rose to their feet with standing ovations—among them being our nation's veterans, whose hearts were especially touched by Shoji's patriotic salutes and the heartfelt thankfulness he always expressed for their service.

Shoji was born in Ishikawa, Japan during the tumultuous years of World War II. He was just over a year old when the atomic bomb was dropped barely a hundred miles from his home in Okayama. Yet in the years after the war, his father rose to become a prominent businessman, a path Shoii



himself was educated to follow. During his early childhood, however, he was introduced to the violin and to the Suzuki method of instruction. Instantly, it became his passion.

When Shoji came upon the country and bluegrass music of America, he instantly fell in love with it. A turning point in his life came when bluegrass music superstar Roy Acuff ("The King of Country Music") toured Japan and Shoji approached him as an ardent fan. Impressed by the young Japanese musician, Acuff invited him to come visit him some day in America. Little did he know, Shoji was to take him up on Continued on page 28.

which Joy Bilyeu sang back in the day. I would be far more nervous singing those two songs in front of Joy than if I had to sing t in front of Dolly! Even though Dolly is an idol, those people like Baldknobbers stars Joy, Dennis, Gene Dove, Bob Leftridge and all the rest—those folks are our idols.

'Our passion is to carry on what was handed down to us. The history, how it evolved for us it's paying tribute and honoring all the Baldknobbers performers who came before us. Even though we weren't there in 1959 or 1989, we want to make sure people see how special it is, as we help carry it on and hopefully hand it to someone else to carry on further." +



FIRST IMPRESSIONS

oco Chanel once said, "Dress shabbily and they remember the dress; dress impeccably and they notice the woman." I keep this quote at top of mind each year when I begin the costuming process, and I strive to achieve the level of "impeccable" that will lead our audience to see each cast member for who they are rather than what he or she is wearing.

Costumes are more than costumes. They are a reflection of personality and a vehicle uncomfortable or unhappy in a costume, for self-expression. Costumes are an extension of our tastes, our style, and the way in which we desire to be perceived. If the costume is wrong, the song is wrong. The lights are wrong. The band is wrong. The costume is the first impression. Before we sing a note or strum a chord, the costume has already set the tone. It is the one thing that remains constant for the entire length of a three minute song. It can't be corrected by perfect pitch, fancy guitar rides or flashing lights. It is out on stage to stay, and if it is wrong, there is not a shred of talent or production that can

The costume can be the difference between good and great. It is the difference between our talents being embraced by the audience or being overshadowed by the narrative our audience has already created from what some simplify as "just clothes". It only takes one piece of fabric and a few seguins for our audience members to write our story, and I have the responsibility to make sure our costumes create the right one.

To many, picking out some sparkly dresses and band shirts seems like an easy task. In today's world, it is a challenge. I must try to find just the right thing that matches the feel and "look" of the song. I must keep in mind current trends and fashion directions. I have to make sure the ultimate costume chosen will match everything and everyone on stage. It needs to coordinate with the lighting. It needs be easily changed in quick-change situations. It needs to pop, sparkle, shimmer. It needs to do everything, while never at the risk of overshadowing the song or upstaging the performer.

I must consider all of this while remaining true to the Baldknobber legacy of class and professionalism.

Did I mention the entertainer wearing the costume must like the costume, feel comfortable in the costume and fit the costume? As entertainers, we must feel confident in our appearance to perform well. When a singer or musician feels good in what he or she is wearing, it shows immediately. If that individual is it is glaringly obvious in his or her performance. A plastered smile cannot hide a bad dress any more than it can hide the dislike held for said dress by a performer.

Thankfully, I don't have to take on the task of costuming alone. I have the help of my extremely talented mother. She is my right-hand, sounding board, "hey, I've got an idea" savior. She is always there to help me plan, carry countless bags of clothes back and forth to the theater and to give the "yay or nay" when I most need it. Just as no gal should have to shop alone, no gal should have to costume alone. My mom is the only reason I ever reach the rhinestone finish line of costuming each season. She will never know what a hugely important role she plays in creating each Baldknobber show.

Most entertainers and musicians will tell you that people hear with their eyes. I have found this to be true. The next time you find yourself at a show, remember someone behind the scenes works tirelessly to make sure that every note you see sparkles with the sequins of excellence.

Shoji eventually arrived in America with not much more than a small pocket full of money and a violin. He toured for a time with other musicians, but soon arrived in Nashville. To the surprise of Roy Acuff, Shoji soon met him in response to that invitation back in Japan! Amazed by the young Japanese musician's talent, Roy soon had Shoji put on stage at the legendary Grand Ol' Opry. That was the beginning.

After years in Nashville and on the road, Shoji discovered Branson, Missouri. He was immediately struck by the kindness of the people and the multitudes of tourists who came to hear country music. He fell in love with the place. (Not only for those reasons, but for the amazing opportunities the area provided for fishing, golf and tennis—his lifelong passions!)

Before long, Shoji was discovered by legendary Branson show business pioneer Chisai Childs who immediately recognized his talent and got him a theater to headline. That was the next beginning.

Then came marriage with Louisiana native Dorothy, a gifted entertainer, show producer and entrepreneur. Dorothy is largely responsible for the extravagant productions of The Shoji Tabuchi Show, and even for those

legendary bathrooms, (that pool table in the men's room, and amazing furniture and fresh orchids in the lady's room.)
Then there were the tuxedo-dressed, white-gloved parking attendants and ushers. Shoji's talented wife and daughter Christina also joined him onstage, along with full orchestra, dancers, singers, acrobats, clowns, aerial artists, Japanese taiko drums—the works!
