





For the Baldknobbers cast, which is headed up by Brandon Mabe, (fourth generation Mabe of the family that "started it all") this new/ old show is the joy of their lives. "I grew up with this show," Branson tells us. "This is a tribute to my family. I'm doing two songs from my Uncle Dennis (Mabe) who I adored growing up. Everything in this show is a tribute to all those who came before us. It's what helped shape us to who and what we are. It's our attempt to pay respects to that. It's what started everything we see in Branson today."

To say that Brandon grew up in this show is an understatement. At the age of six he had already memorized all the show's comedy routines and confidently strode out on stage to perform them—which was not planned! The elders had to quickly give him "the hook"—but the audience thought it was all part of the comedy and they roared!

Says Megan, Brandon's wife and co-star, "I'm going to sing two Dolly Parton songs—two which **Joy Bilyeu** sang back in the day. I would be far more nervous singing those two songs in front of Joy than if I had to sing them in front of Dolly! Even though Dolly is an idol, those people like Baldknobbers stars **Joy, Dennis**,

Gene Dove, Bob Leftridge and all the rest—those folks are our idols! It's almost nerve-wracking to sing the songs that they sang! And wearing those iconic costumes—wearing what your idols wore is just stunning! Brandon grew up with it, but soon after I fell in love with Brandon, I fell in love with The Baldknobbers! Our passion is to carry on what was handed down to us. The history, how it evolvedfor us it's paying tribute and honoring all the Baldknobbers performers who came before us. I have a love affair with my husband but I also have a love affair with the legacy of the Baldknobbers. In a very strange yet special way, our life is the Baldknobbers. Even though we weren't there in 1959 or 1989, we want to make sure people see how special it is, as we help carry it on and hopefully hand it to someone else to carry on further." +





Randy McConnell November 5, 1961 – July 18, 2021

n the 18th of July, we lost our beloved bass player, Randy McConnell. He became one of the thousands who have fallen victim to the deadly virus plaguing our world. To us, Randy was more than a number—more

Randy was more than a number—more than a statistic—he was family. He was not only a loving husband and father, but he was also an incredible talent and one of the strongest and most passionate Christians I have had the honor to know.

In his final days, Randy was on fire for God. He had witnessed so much pain and heartache during his time in the hospital, but he couldn't wait to get out and tell as many as he could about the way God had deeply touched him and strengthened his faith. He wanted to be a testimony for God. He wanted to share how God had blessed him with incredible doctors and nurses. They had shown him a compassion, love and respect that truly affected him deeply. Even in the darkest and most difficult period of his life struggling moment by moment for each breath—Randy was looking for the beauty and blessing of God.

> If he knew how his final days impacted me and so many others, Randy would know that he will forever live on as a testimony of faith, perseverance and love.

> Randy showed me that faith can lead us through the darkest and most trying storms of life. He showed me that problems are only blessings—tiny mountains to climb. With a Randy-sized faith, the struggles we face are just beautiful opportunities God gifts us. They are a chance to "hang a little deeper with Jesus". Struggles are where the deepest blessings rest. In

darkness comes the strongest faith—the reminder that there is a hand reaching for each of us. We simply need to find the trust to grab it.

Randy knew this. In his final days, he was holding the hand of God so tightly, he couldn't wait to share the peace and joy that God had given him. His savior was beside him and all around him. He was inspired to fight harder—not only for his own desires to return home to his loved ones—but for the opportunity to spread his knowledge of Christ to others. He had a new outlook on life, and he was ready to start sharing that light with as many as he could.

How could a man going through so much be so joyous in faith?

When we found out Randy's condition was worsening, we prayed for a miracle—for Randy to come home. When he passed, my heart felt broken. Why didn't we get our miracle? It wasn't until days later that I realized, we did receive a miracle, it just wasn't as simple as the one for which we had prayed.

Randy left this world with an impassioned and renewed faith. He left as an example of how to handle life's pain and struggle. He sought the Lord and found him in the darkness. He left with an open and loving heart. He gave us the definition of faith—faith through pain. He showed us joy through grief. He taught us love through trial.

Randy was the miracle.

His lasting impact will live on in all of those who knew him. Randy taught me to live in faith, love deeply and persevere through the storms of life. He taught me to focus on Christ and a constant goal to spread His love to as many as we can in our short time on this earth. He made me a better person for knowing him, and for that I am eternally thankful.

THE GIFT

Decently, Branson's beloved Elvis Presley tribute artist (and Elvis's cousin) Jerry Presley received the surprise of a lifetime from his iconic cousin. Although Jerry had received several gifts from Elvis during the music legend's lifetime, what happened on Jerry's Branson stage a few weeks ago left him speechless, if not absolutely flabbergasted! He recognized Elvis's longtime personal friend Ed Russell approaching the stage, but what Ed had in his hand was a show stopper if there ever was one! Jerry recognized it immediately, which is why he was guick to hand his microphone over to Ed. The famous Nashville record producer and former president of Castle Records then began his story. It was the story of how Elvis had given him one of the legendary TCB necklaces (Taking Care of Business) that he had given to several other friends and admirers, which today are worth fortunes and which inspired millions of replicas. As Ed told the Branson audience, "Since Jerry was one of the original Elvis tribute artists out there, and since he was Elvis's cousin, and was working so hard to keep Elvis's name alive, well," said Ed, pausing to gather his words—and emotions, "I really just thought Jerry ought to have it."

We couldn't agree more. There was scarcely a dry eye in the house.
