





What all had just witnessed was a



Monster prehistoric sea creatures now inhabit a new 21,000 gallon tank eight feet tall, (with windows), while prehistoric reptiles lurk nearby. Meanwhile, animatronic dinosaurs growl and roar to provide goosebumps and photo ops.

For adventurers eager to take on another, somewhat different type of safari, we direct you a few short miles down the road to Wild Valley at Branson West. another masterful attraction created and operated by James and Lisa. This one is 100 percent designed around animal interactions, (some at different levels of course, since animals vary from kangaroos to cuddle to lions and tigers to feed from a wise distance.)


