

After performing his show on a cruise ship in Hawaii, Garry was approached at the post show "meet'n' greet" by a Mom, a Grandma, two Aunts, and a young lady with them who immediately caught his eye. Turns out, like him, the young lady lived back in Vegas, a town that allowed the New York native to pursue all her interests, and even bring life to some of her dreams. She was an EMT nurse. That was her passion. But since childhood, she also loved to perform. That interest led to a side hobby of modeling, performing in Vegas, and eventually, to designing costumes: a craft she surely has mastered, (as us audience types will verify). For both of these two, it was the beginning of a whole new world.

Vegas & Beyond!

Back in Vegas, they reunited. First came love, then came marriage, then came this amazing twosome making magic together all over the world—Janine performing with her husband, designing costumes, managing a blizzard of showbiz details—and eventually adding "backstage Mom" to her resume. That came about by the birth of Sophia, now 3 years old. Which, once again, changed everything.

"By the time Sophia was sixteen months old," as Garry told *The Insider*, "she had been on 42 planes and had a handful of passports and visas. We felt it was time to slow down a bit. We loved all our animals, but we knew it was time to get them off the road and to give them new homes. It was heartbreaking, but the regulations just began to get overwhelming. We had several offers to perform in Vegas, but what we liked about Branson was the concept of shows without gambling. We decided to offer something different from Branson's other magic shows, all which are awesome by the way, so to Branson we came and here we are.

tables. Fortunes were spent on revamping the theater's inside. Outside is still a work in progress. Hopefully, it won't be too long before it begins to resemble the design envisioned by Janine. (Honestly, is there anything this lady can't do?")

But here's what's really special: the show is rapid-fire, funny and astounding, but not at all hyper. In fact, it's so relaxed and casual that audiences are stunned when the 90 minutes are over! (No intermission, Just woosh! And it's over!) Dinner at 5, show gets out by 7. Then it's woosh! On to an 8pm show elsewhere, or woosh, back to the lodging to just kick back and chill.

A devout Christian, Jerry's life has not suffered the turbulence that befell Elvis—yet the kindness, respect, generosity and even heart for God that Elvis was known for—is alive and well in cousin Jerry Presley—the one we believe to be very much the keeper of the flame.

 Jerry is related to Elvis 3 ways was one of the first Elvis tribute artists out there • Elvis's Manager Colonel Parker disapproved of Jerry • Elvis came to Jerry's rescue, encouraging him • Jerry attended over 13 Elvis concerts • He hung out with Elvis at Graceland • He treasures several gifts Elvis gave him • He met briefly with Elvis backstage in July of '77 • In August, he received a note from Elvis apologizing for the short meeting and inviting him back to Graceland • Days later, Elvis died • At Graceland after the funeral, Jerry ran into Elvis's Dad Vester sitting on the stairs. "I guess it will never be the same around here anymore," said Jerry. With tears in his eyes, Vester answered, "No, Son, I guess it never will be." • "Elvis was a humble guy," says Jerry. "He didn't put himself up on a pedestal. He loved people. He was such a giving person. There will never be another Elvis."

Many lemur species have already gone extinct in the last 2000 years due to human activity. Because of these threats and their declining numbers, environmentalist groups consider lemurs to be the world's most endangered mammals, noting that as of 2013 up to 90% of all lemur species confront the threat of extinction in the wild within the next 20 to 25 years. Many efforts try to preserve lemur habitats as well as promote public awareness and appreciation for lemurs.
