wasn't hard to get noticed and I'm not

that old but I'm old enough to go around

before the computers are around so the
02:57
government was still looking for people
02:58
who were good at things and they could
03:00
put them to work so I started doing
03:04
encryption algorithms basic things to
03:07
time not let him to satellite work and
03:12
while I was in college grad school and
03:14
then afterwards I went in the military I
03:17
was in the Army for 13 years it was all
03:21
in the SF community I won't narrow down
03:24
any more than that right now and of
03:26
course throughout then I was still
03:28
consulting although the time tables
03:30
didn't match up always and stokin so

he's still involved with different

aspects of the intelligence community

because of my past work I still

maintained all my clearances and even

picked up some others that led into

after the military the civilian side of

little and I thought as I was growing up

it's naughty over smart teenager that I

did enough bad stuff it was the voice in

my head would stop and it just got
04:30
stronger but uh I've actually smartened

up an anthemic line and everything was
04:37
going very well and this would be about

2000 at this point and then the car is

September 11th which changed not only my

world but everyone's so I was still

consulting on various projects and still

maintain the clearances so we were going

against that and having had connections

connected to the very highest levels of

certain terrorist organizations not he

was a terrorist but that he was born to

it he his neighbor in other mentions

name his neighbor in Egypt he grew up

with was Ayman al-zawahiri the
06:17
Osama bin Laden's right-hand man the guy
06:22
with the white beard you see on all the
06:23
videos what there's a lot now they grew
06:26
up together high school together college
06:28
medical school they actually started in
06:31
separate medical schools but avens
06:33
father was a professor who taught him
06:35
and then they got together for graduate
06:37
school that's held once they knew each
06:38
other he was a member by birth of the
06:43
Muslim Brotherhood he was his family he
06:47
was a family member or not fact number
06:50
two but right at the very beginning of

06:54
agama Ellis Lamia which is a terrorist
06:57
organization now but the time as a
06:59
radical student organization as how far
07:01
back he goes and he joined it in college
07:05
and actually some of the sex did some
07:09
violence and the cost of his surgical
07:10
career he had to leave school at the
07:13
same time hidden names had left he came
07:15
here and even announced our hearing with
07:16
overseas to get away from it but it
07:20
seems a physician but it did cost in
07:21
that and he pours the violence I don't
07:24
discuss children at all but he would not
07:27
even raise his children in that faith
07:29
because he importance too much anyway
07:33
because I knew him and because of my
07:35
previous background and connections in
07:37
the community I was accepted by him and
07:39
many of his friends who turned out to be
07:41
at the very highest levels on the
07:43
terrace emerge throughout the world
07:44
I have personally spoken more than once
07:47
with havens Alighieri this is prior to
07:51
2016 and those are documented the FBI
07:55
has them so nothing nothing you know
07:58
behind the scenes there I've also spoken
08:00
to Homs of Islam who was Osama bin
08:05
Laden's eldest surviving son and he was

08:10
recently killed and he was actually
08:12
going to be the new head of the
08:14
resurgent al-qaeda
08:16
server this gentleman had yeah
08:21
al-qaeda's making a comeback as soon as
08:22
Isis was gone they intend to establish
08:24
themselves again they might say he was
08:28
at the very top by birth these people
08:30
and there's a huge network in this
08:31
country hello
08:32
overseas certainly but in this country
08:34
as well of people who are varying
08:37
degrees of violent but they support it

some of them are very public people you

know and it's all very behind-the-scenes

extremely violent funnel money into them

there are thousands thousand people who

with his information because he did not

like the violent stuff I started

supplying information that I learned

from this relationship to my local law

that I supply they would disseminate it

to various federal agencies because all

I was going across state lines with
09:23
weapons explosives things like that
09:25
cigarettes and starting around 2007 I
09:36
started to really delivering the
09:38
information directly to the DOJ in
09:40
Baltimore
09:41
in 2008 I started dealing directly with
09:46
the roser side in Baltimore now from
09:51
approximately 2006
09:53
until this time my information was
09:56
getting to John brother lessons prior to
10:00
the CIA director course and probably
10:03
right right for homeland security
10:05
director so he was getting it but not
10:09
directly at that time so they liked the
10:15
information they did not have anyone
10:16
with that level at the very top it was
10:20
dangerous they made that very clear and
10:22
they made clear I didn't have to but
10:25
they were extremely grateful for it and
10:28
at the time of course right after
10:29
September 11th
10:30
I felt it was my duty I worked in
10:32
defense my entire life and so this is
10:35
what came to be then I was going to
10:37
protect the country this way so I did
10:42
this and I said to the voices various

10:46
people like the deep state and
10:50
everything was going fine I testified
10:52
most often secretly or by deposition by
10:56
remote video in different terrorist
10:59
cases and those people are in prison we
11:03
stopped we stopped quite a bit of stuff
11:05
there there dozens of those cases
11:09
there's more than once where my wife and
11:12
I have had to go into protection because
11:14
our death threats are still are but and
11:17
she didn't like this but this was our
11:20
duty I mean this is to save lives it did
11:24
so we were going along like this until
11:29
2009
11:31
that's what things changed things
11:35
changed and what changed was Obama was
11:39
elected the entire focus left the
11:44
terrorists of Muslim terrorists and went
11:46
to white terrorism he couldn't say
11:49
anything bad now as I knew for a fact
11:53
there are some very good Muslims out
11:54
there they're very good people who
11:55
happen to be Muslim like my doctor
11:58
friend his brother is my current contact
12:03
and extremely violent I'm also happy
12:05
more about that but he is very proud to
12:07
be at the top of that my own stuff but
12:09
there are creepy but I have right now on

my phone my wife and I went out to get
12:16
something to eat
12:17
it was one of days I thought I could eat
12:19
there was a homeless couple white couple
12:22
and they were obviously own drugstores
12:25
all over him it was a guy who's buying
12:26
him lunch he was Muslim he's standing
12:29
and we talked a bit and you couldn't
12:32
even tell by looking at me but then he
12:33
got their food gave it to them he got
12:35
his food and walked over and his wife is
12:37
over there she's wearing the burqa and
12:40
there's his father his father was
12:42
Iranian in a wheelchair I spoke with him
12:45
a little bit here he's tell me about
12:47
this you know what it was like before
12:48
this horrible you know religious
12:50
whatever so really nice couple so there
12:55
are a lot of people like that I want to
12:56
say they're all terrorists or not I have
12:59
contacts I'm not gonna elaborate with in
13:01
Iran who are fighting within the system
13:05
that's all I'm on the side because they
13:07
don't like the government there so
13:11
everything changed in 2009 here's what's
13:15
going to get bad because of the focus
13:22
was changed the focus was changed to
13:24
what they returned mean white terrorism

13:26
war sovereign citizen terrorism and
13:28
there was quite a bit while was
13:30
legitimate I worked on those cases as
13:33
well because they would cross it over
13:35
especially with weapons and things but a
13:40
case came up where they were funding
13:46
stuff with drugs weapons to get this was
13:51
a big one I want to expose it but it was
13:55
very highly placed it's very highly
13:57
connected so I reported it like normal
14:01
to well Obama shut it down they came
14:05
after me and my wife they arrested us
14:07
what we were arrested no I was arrested
14:12
going to work
14:13
she was arrested our home by two giant
14:16
car one picked her up now she was a very
14:17
petite picked her up to her against the
14:19
wall where she couldn't get out for
14:21
about an hour then they cuffed her
14:23
laying there and left her there
14:24
for several hours I kept her cuffed
14:26
behind her back for 22 hours it gets
14:31
worse
14:32
sorry I'm not doing this for sympathy I
14:35
want people to understand the level of
14:37
the deep state will go to keep things
14:39
quiet I was exposing their operation one
14:44
that they wanted so rest of us holding

14:50
up the charges they said I was selling
14:52
drugs now I was reporting will
14:53
illegal drug sales with the help of
14:56
several federal agents but they turned
14:59
it around on me
15:00
now I've had multiple US prosecutors and
15:04
look at these yards look at the case
15:05
they all agree is completely fabricated
15:06
and is being addressed there were four
15:09
agents involved directly with me at that
15:12
time
15:12
tor in prison already okay
15:15
ones on indictment and one clip so they
15:18
know they're guilty we aren't
15:21
but rest of us through in prison so I'm
15:27
staying in a local jail and waiting
15:32
because I'm half laughing to myself it's
15:34
like where do you find out who I work
15:35
for you idiot you know and I call and
15:39
the people that I worked with for years
15:41
saving lives in court cases on the
15:44
record not only didn't help me but
15:47
helped Obama rod resistance screwed me
15:51
over and helped them they tried to bury
15:56
me so put me in it gets worse wouldn't
16:02
help this is one reason I don't like him
16:05
wouldn't back me up a bit went with them
16:08
but you know he got his promotion a no

16:09
it didn't me he was the only US Attorney
16:12
under Obama that kept his job and he was
16:15
supposedly a Republican so I'm sure he's
16:20
also turning other ways we'll get to it
16:22
okay so I'm in there this is a local
16:27
this is a county jail attorneys are in
16:32
on it and ones facing disbarment because
16:34
of it but at the time was this is 2009
16:38
I put me in their unlocked away no food
16:43
I was not being fed I had about 600
16:46
calories a week I was getting regular
16:50
interrogations I mean beating when they
16:54
image you know that now this is all
16:57
documented I have affidavits from the
16:58
warden and the sheriff Wow
17:01
so they would come out of these these
17:03
feds would come up they wanted to know
17:04
what I knew how exposed they were and
17:07
any evidence I clicked because they knew
17:09
that I documented it they threatened my
17:12
wife he told me that if I don't give
17:14
them stuff they're gonna lock her up for
17:16
a year and they're gonna have a raped
17:17
killed they did this over and over again
17:22
maybe we wouldn't offence when the feds
17:25
showed up they would take me up to a
17:27
private area and leave me with them when
17:31
I got out of that little four hour

17:33
session I was in such bad shape this the
17:35
guard the CEO did not want to sign for
17:37
me back in his custody he complained to
17:42
the board some warden said okay now we
17:46
want somebody in the hallway so next
17:50
time I showed up got me back up there
17:52
they're doing the same thing even worse
17:54
because I wanted to cooperate the guards
17:57
sitting in the hallway he got physically
17:58
ill listening to what was going on he
18:01
told the warden warden says okay now we
18:05
want a guard in the room so next time I
18:08
show up this was like every other day
18:10
next time you show up have a guard Co
18:14
armed in the room at this time the word
18:18
made them check their firearms just in
18:20
case there's trouble so only the co was
18:23
armed so they toned it they towed it way
18:26
down because the guard was a witness and
18:28
even that he got physically ill and
18:30
stopped it after two hours and took me
18:32
out of there that's how bad that was and
18:35
that's how bad they were with him in the
18:36
room the warden then barred them from
18:39
entering his facility ever again and
18:42
made a formal complaint to the sheriff
18:44
they knew it was crap the warning went
18:47
to the sheriff had tried to get me out

18:48
by passing the judge on their own
18:50
authority which they can actually do
18:52
that's how bad this was so I got no food
18:57
nothing it's worse then they couldn't
19:01
come in but they could assign me out so
19:04
if you actually look at the record which
19:05
is all documented you'll see where they
19:07
supposedly signed me out to take me to
19:09
look at
19:10
evidence take me here for an
19:12
interrogation take me here for
19:13
discussion and they're signing you no
19:15
other facilities but and that's on the
19:17
record but I never made it in his
19:18
facilities
19:19
it took me somewhere else I don't think
19:22
it's a real word they call it internal
19:23
rendition you know like extreme
19:25
rendition
19:26
this was an internal rendition so I lost
19:32
147 pounds in four and a half months I I
19:38
was force-fed insecticide it was called
19:42
dichlorvos she used to migratory it's I
19:46
was force-fed a lot of stuff he sees all
19:49
kinds of self ground glass this is why I
19:51
have the damage to this day about eating
19:53
I was force-fed dichlorvos wishes they
20:00
sprayed on crops and migratory birds eat

20:02
it and they bleed that they eats out
20:03
their stomach which is what it did I'm
20:05
just bigger than a migratory bird so it
20:07
took longer I was what aborted a turkey
20:12
water boring with kerosene and once with
20:15
kerosene and diesel fuel mix you've
20:18
never felt burning like that in your
20:20
life
20:21
I had I needed seven and a half hours of
20:27
corrective surgery or my sinuses and my
20:29
nasal passages and the other remove the
20:32
bone in between my eyes and above my
20:33
eyes to get up there because it faded
20:36
away okay I just kind of get through it
20:49
by Road now I know I try not to relive
20:53
it as I talk about when I didn't die
20:58
they just tried to see what they could
21:00
do to make me die number one that after
21:05
a particularly brutal session they beat
21:08
the hell I mean by this point I weighed
21:11
less than half of what I had nor my way
21:13
and they be Tom you threw me the corner
21:16
of a cell block the door guy didn't move
21:19
for like three days when I'm came in
21:23
and I was such a bad shape he was angry
21:26
that he couldn't get his jollies so he
21:29
just kicked me in the stomach until
21:31
about eight inches of my intestine

21:32
distended from my rectum and I all I
21:38
could do is look at him I couldn't
21:39
couldn't booth so it was a bad situation
21:44
and I remember to this day having to
21:48
recall him while we were training I had
21:51
to put that back inside me without
21:53
twisting everything anyway this is how
21:57
bad it was
21:59
now these both people so after this got
22:04
out and I've been in like a constant
22:08
surveillance since then and I've had to
22:13
maintain my contact with them under
22:16
threat of death and death to me that's
22:19
my wife death to my family
22:20
he said just in case you ever were
22:22
thinking of getting divorced they showed
22:24
me pictures of my brother and we know he
22:26
has children this is how they are so I
22:29
had to continue to work for them which I
22:31
did send and this was their manipulation
22:40
this is under Obama this is why I've met
22:42
every president since Carter and I met
22:45
Carter after he left office she was
22:47
going to Habitat for Humanity and it was
22:50
Obama who refused to meet me you wonder
22:53
why believe me I'd like to meet him so I
23:01
forced to work with them they had
23:03
something that they could use and they

23:05
are experts at using people they had my
23:09
brain and my clearances in my background
23:11
and there was no culpability for them
23:15
then I was not a part of this agency or
23:17
that one so there was deniability they
23:20
loved it so I was tasked with various

things I mean on top of having

maintaining these terrorist ties they

wanted increasingly more and more

details and more and more deeper

information

that was dangerous to get it was putting
23:35
me in jeopardy putting my wife in
23:37
jeopardy you know we took precautions
23:40
there are lots of cautions but people do
23:43
this I mean just one or more more more
23:44
they didn't care
23:45
on top of that we want me to help with
23:48
their computer system when we help with
23:52
with you know setting this up the
23:54
architecture for this architecture for
23:56
that all the time I have to feed this
23:58
information and you know you're
24:00
completely controlled and then you would
24:02
have been tasking you with different
24:04
things because I was a think-tank kind
24:06
of guy I've been like I said I consult
24:08
and you think tank cut up stuff so I had

24:11
somebody they could bring their dumbest
24:13
illegal problems to and you can figure
24:15
out a valid way to do it
24:16
of course we don't we'll have your wife
24:18
rape and kill so and so I I was doing
24:28
that I had no choice I liked it I was
24:30
there to use and they did and it grew
24:36
because it changed though because they
24:40
did not want the valid information from
24:43
inside these terrorist organizations to
24:47
stop what was going on they wanted more
24:49
more information to find out what their
24:52
exposure was if their illegal operations
24:54
had been compromised and to cover their
24:57
butt so they turned it around from
25:01
something positive to they were using it
25:03
to cover their ass and that's why they
25:06
wanted more and more a month and I was
25:12
working through the working through the
25:14
Baltimore office I was I would answer
25:16
directly rod Rosen they kept me pretty
25:18
close because of my background it wasn't
25:21
a normal agent and didn't want me
25:24
talking to many people there was a group
25:25
down there and they were made up of
25:27
federal agents and DOJ people and the
25:31
one of them actually ended up knowing
25:33
he's a computer expert forensic expert

and I actually known his family as
25:39
in-laws for many many years and then I
25:43
met him there we cruise hit it off and
25:46
he's very intelligent
25:47
and he was very upset about how they
25:53
treated him now he was a federal agent
25:55
hanging the Secret Service I won't name
25:57
where I thought he was very smart he was
26:01
a computer genius he really was he's
26:03
just most people who know it like that
26:05
you know you can breathe and they would
26:08
give him yeah that helped him but they
26:11
would give him tasks you know do this do
26:13
that most of the legal a long kind
26:15
another illegal surveillance fabricating
26:17
evidence planting evidence and they just
26:19
they do this he would figure out how to

do it because he's good at it and then

he would try to explain how difficult it

was and they just didn't get it and then

next week they would ask him to fix his

cable you know that fixed our cable and

Service agent so he was their top

different operations operations that

turned out to be started by the FBI in

many instances as false flags and this

this information of these actions these

plans the equipment things like this
27:22
would come back and they would circle

through these different organizations I

dealt with so you get wind of this stuff

your research you get war info we turned
27:30
in you find out they're the ones doing
27:31
it they started it was a false flag
27:33
there have been many false flags didn't
27:35
get off the ground or didn't succeed and

almost all of them run out of Boston DC
27:43
is the politics New York gist of money

and Boston is a false flag the
27:48
operations they call it and it goes

right to Mueller he's run there Muir so

I'm doing two things I'm keeping my ties

this I was crippled up I was on a walker

at times in wheelchair I lost all the

weight I couldn't walk a lot of health

problems trying to recover and Brennan
28:54
referred to me as that effing cripple he
28:56
talked I was funny because I couldn't

take it

this is what I'm responsible for and

thought he had done it and yet he
29:05
thought it was funny and cut that was
29:08
his pet name for me so I never forgot of
29:15
course what they had done in the threats
29:16
that we lived under daily I've had phone
29:18
calls court I've had you know visits at
29:22
work on stuff notes it's lightened up
29:24
some there were nasty threats especially
29:27
around love the election time well then

when they felt the power slipping away
29:36
I'm not picking rotted out a hat I
29:38
worked with him I have lots and lots of
29:40
proof I get his name with a ton of stuff
29:41
suck it up ride your days coming so
29:47
while this is happening while I'm doing
29:49
the terrorist stuff I've got all the
29:51
paperwork for that because in the
29:53
beginning they tried to write it up as a
29:54
contract and either seeing these things
29:57
I've had US prosecutors look at now like

are you kidding me it's like you know

who wrote that and why would your

attorney ever even look at this and not

laugh

otherwise was the marshals of the Secret

Service of the FBI and CIA NSA so

through all their and was unrestricted

because it was just tied right it was
30:58
wide open but I was supposed to be

restricted to only the people working on

it in this one location and the people
31:09
watching over them because it was just
31:10
it was supposed to be a testbed to see

if it would work and it ended up and
31:14
running well this was they were using it
31:17
like an unregistered you know no no
31:21
oversight intelligence community because
31:23
it was hooked into everything they were
31:25
taking information off of it they were
31:27
selling that they were shipping it
31:28
overseas
31:28
this is what I've documented the now
31:33
they have they still do they still do
31:37
but now it's kind of now its segment and
31:39
now there's there's clearance just given
31:41
everything at the time it was wide open
31:43
and they used it all up Hillary Obama
31:46
when who was wrong them was bragging

about Obama's secret database that's

what she was bragging about Wow

this mean this is where hammer came from

in law enforcement together which is
