



STATEMENT OF SUFFICIENCY

August 21, 2018

On August 13, 2018, Jennifer Hope, a nonpartisan candidate for Regional Transportation District (RTD) Board of Directors, District N, submitted petition 26 signatures to the Secretary of State to cure her previously insufficient candidate petition. The candidate seeks nomination to the November 6, 2018, general election ballot. Under Colorado law, Ms. Hope's petition must contain at least 250 valid signatures.<sup>1</sup>
