How it works

Washer and Dryer:

- The washer and dryer are available for your use along with laundry detergent and dryer sheets. Please shake the sand out of any clothes or bathing suits before using the washer and dryer.

Television:

- The TVs have a selection of streaming services including Netflix, Amazon, and Spotify for your use and enjoyment.

Trash & Recycling:

- Trash and recycling are mixed and can be bagged up and put in the trash cans near the outside of the garage. There are spare trash bags in the pantry. City trash collection days are Mondays and Thursdays.

Guest Policy:

- The only people permitted at the house are the people on your reservation that have provided drivers licenses in advance of your stay. Please do not invite any other guests to visit or stay at the house.

Garbage Disposal:

- Next to the sink is a button that operates the garbage disposal. Push to start and push again to stop.

The Beach & Dunes:

- The property has a private beach crossover for the exclusive access of guests directly across the street. Please be careful to stay off the dunes and boulders and avoid any marked turtle nesting sites.

Sand & Salty Air:

- While the salty air is beautiful outdoors, it is corrosive to furniture and fixtures indoors. We ask that you please keep the windows and doors closed to prevent too much salty air from entering the house and shake sand off outside.

Garage Play Room:

- Please help yourself to the ping pong table and basketball arcade game in the garage. There are also sand toys for your use in a bucket in the garage as well as beach chairs.

Living Room Fireplace and Fan:

- There is a remote for the fireplace on top of the fireplace. Instructions are on the back. The fireplace can be used on a heat setting, or on just a visual setting without any heat. The living room fan is activated by the switch on the wall behind the leather lounge chair and then the remote that is also on top of the fireplace.

Exterior Lighting:

- Please keep all exterior lights facing the ocean 'off' because it is turtle nesting season. There are exterior lights on the driveway side of the property that will automatically turn on at dusk and turn off a few hours later.

Beach Chairs:

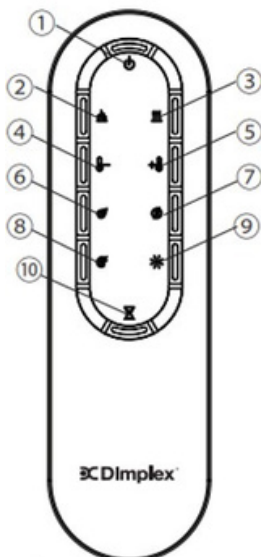
- There are four foldable beach chairs in the garage for your use. Please dust off all sand before returning them to the garage..

Air Conditioning:

- The house is serviced by two AC units, one for the upstairs and one for the downstairs. The thermostats are located by the drop zone downstairs and by the 4th bedroom door upstairs. These can be manually adjusted by using the touch screen to select the temperature that you would like. .

Remote Instructions:

- Instructions for use of the fireplace and the first floor blinds can be found below:



Fireplace Remote

1. Turns unit On or Off
2. Flame On/Off: Turns the flame effect On or Off.
3. Heat On/Off: Turns the heater On or Off.
4. Temperature Down: Decreases the heat output.
5. Temperature Up: Increases the heat output.
6. Better not to use
7. Better not to use
8. Changes the fire to multiple colors
9. Changes the brightness of the lights in the unit
10. Better not to use

Blinds Remote

The blinds are numbered 1-4 with '1' being the left most blind on the side of the house by the kitchen. '4' is closest to the fireplace

On the remote, use the left or right buttons to toggle over until you see all numbers 1-4 with circles around them, and then press the up or down button for all of the blinds to go up or down

/ FLAGLER BEACH DOWNTOWN

Before you go

LINENS AND TOWELS

Strip all of the beds and put all of the sheets and blankets in a pile in front of the washing machine. Please do the same with all towels and washcloths.

TV | LIGHTS | HOSES

Turn off all lights, tv's and electrical devices inside and outside the house. Please make sure all outdoor hoses are turned off if you used them.

FRIDGE & DISHES

Ensure all food and drinks are emptied from the fridge and thrown away. Please clear out any drawers, cabinets, or coolers where you might have stored food and dispose of it in the trash. Please pre-rinse all dishes and cups and place in the dishwasher and turn on the dishwasher.

TRASH

Bag up all trash tightly and dispose of it in the trash cans at the front garage side of the house. There are extra trash bags in the pantry. Please ensure the beach walkover and beach area is cleared of any trash and all beach toys and furniture have been stowed away for next time.
