Crosslake RV Supplemental Rules Lake Access

Limited Lake access while construction is ongoing:

Only Friday Evenings after 6pm, Saturdays and Sundays.

(This schedule might be adjusted as needed so if you see equipment of any type working, please stay clear of it for safety.)

- a. **Enter the pond/lake area at your own risk** as there are continued ongoing construction. Be aware that there are holes, stumps, equipment, supplies, materials and 'stuff' stockpiled everywhere along this lake side construction phase.
- b. Lake access area: ONLY between Peace St (where the dumpsters are located) and Joy St (office/laundry building is located.) where you see sod is laid in new sites
- c. **NO swimming, diving, boating, kayaking** allowed in any of the waters at this park at this time.
- d. **Dogs**:
 - 1. **Dog Swimming**: Dog may swim in the pond/lake, not humans!
 - 2. NO CROSSING over the Lake where livestock are located.
 - 3. **Supervise your dog at all times**: Keep an eye on your dog and be in control of them to ensure their safety and the safety of others.
 - 4. **Clean up after your dog**: Clean up after your dog's accidents to maintain a clean and healthy environment for all.
 - 5. **One adult human per dog**: Pet owners are expected to have one adult human per dog. Waivers may be available for those with multiple dogs that can show good recall and behavior.
 - 6. **Respect other guests**: Be respectful of other guest's wishes and adjust your dog's behavior if they are causing angst for another dog or human. Leave the area if necessary.
 - 7. **Leash rule:** is to be in used as soon as your dog exits the lake/pond.
 - 8. NO TOYS allowed in the water.
 - 9. Keep your swimming dog away from any fountains

e. Fishing:

- 1. Catch and release fishing is allowed in lake/pond
- 2. **Guest fishing:** Day passes at an additional cost for your friends and liability waivers are available at the office or by email.
- 3. Please post your catches on our social media pages!

Disclaimer: For purposes of definition, the 'pond' is the small brim pond with the fountain next to Lot 40 and the recreational pole barn, while the 'lake' is the big lake across the road from there. However, the words 'pond' and 'lake' shall be used interchangeably at this park and by implication either shall refer to any and all bodies of water on this property including ditches that may hold water. Also, wild animals such as alligators, snakes of all kinds, spiders, biting insects, frogs and "creepy crawlies" might be encountered at, in or near the ponds and entering these pond areas are at your own risk and by entering upon and using any of the recreational opportunities in this park, you are freely accepting the risk and any and all liability associated with it.

Crosslake RV Supplemental Rules July 4th, 2024

4th of July Fireworks Rules:

- i. CrossLake RV requires a liability waiver to be signed by all adults engaging in this activity.
- ii. CrossLake RV allows fireworks from 6pm-10pm on Thursday July 4th.
- iii. CrossLake RV fireworks area South lakeside ONLY.
- iv. Only point over the lake. Never point fireworks at another person or RV, nor towards the RV park.
- v. If you are impaired by alcohol/drugs, you may not engage in the use of fireworks even if you signed the liability waiver.
- vi. Only legal fireworks allowed. Only use fireworks that are designated to not travel large distances. The intent is to keep your fireworks from crossing the full width of the lake. Fireworks and explosives that has an unpredictable direction or that is by nature unpredictable are NOT allowed here.
- vii. It is illegal in Florida to use fireworks, including shells and mortars, multiple tube devices, Roman candles, rockets, and firecrackers, when such use is not in strict compliance with Chapter 791.012, Florida Statutes.
- viii. Clean up all debris and trash afterwards. Leave it as you found it to help keep our natural areas beautiful.
