

This past week we celebrated the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We have a statue of the Sacred Heart in our Church around which many of you gather to light candles and pray. This year's Gospel reading for the feast was taken from John and described the moment the soldiers went to break the bones of those crucified and - as Jesus was already dead - we remember that they did not break his legs but pierced his side instead. This was to fulfil the scripture - from the prophecy of Isaiah - that "not one of His bones shall be broken". Yet while His bones remained unbroken, His heart certainly was. Jesus' heart is often depicted in the traditional imagery of the Sacred Heart statue as surrounded by the crown of thorns. In accepting the consequences of sin we remember Jesus was prepared to suffer and - as He loved so much - His suffering was greater in loving when unloved, caring when un-cared for and giving when utterly rejected and neglected. His willingness to surrender to suffering out of love for us is where we can find inspiration to do the same whenever we are faced with challenges in this regard. May the Sacred Heart of Jesus intercede for each one of us and those in particular need to be given the strength to persevere when we suffer as He suffered.
