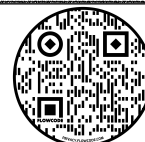
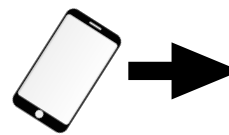

Over these past weeks we have heard Jesus teach us through parables about how we are to approach God and one another and a theme throughout the parables of Luke - which we considered last week in the story of the rich man and Lazarus - is that we have been entrusted with much. This theme is made more explicit in the parable of the good steward (who looked after his Master's riches) from which we get the term Stewardship. We can consider our Stewardship of creation - an important responsibility - or our stewardship of the wealth entrusted to us as individuals, however, this weekend we are invited to reflect upon our stewardship of this parish: of the riches of God's grace in Our Lord Jesus Christ which we are entrusted with in our participation at Mass in our Church to bring to others. We give thanks to God for the gift of our parish and the privilege of being able to worship together here every Sunday. It's a privilege I've been reminded of in speaking to Father Godfrey whose ministry used to take him hours of travel on a motorbike to reach outstations where people were only able to come to Mass (travelling for hours themselves to do so) once a month. How privileged we are to do this with comparative ease every Sunday! Today we will hear from members of our Parish Finance Committee after all Masses about the importance of supporting our parish via the Gift-Aid scheme. This does not cost a penny and we are not appealing for money but instead want to take this opportunity to thank you for your generosity without which we simply would not be here today. We are entirely self-sustaining as a parish and this is something to marvel at and a great achievement for us. Thank you to each of you who give to us regularly by cash, contactless, standing order or envelope. Thank you to those who bought shrubs for our garden, donated items for our fair, supported our children going on holiday and also give of your time and talent in the various different ways you are able. Most importantly we thank God for the source of this generosity which is His grace through which we come to life by our choosing to love Him and one another.
