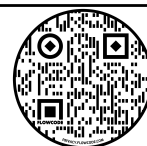

Eternal rest give unto them, O Lord, and may perpetual light shine upon them. May their souls - and the souls of all the faithful departed - rest in peace. Amen.

Last month our Holy Father - Pope Leo XIV - addressed members of the Diplomatic Corps (those representing all the nations of the world) at the Vatican. During his address he said: "no policy can genuinely serve the people if it denies the unborn the gift of life." The subject of abortion is understandably sensitive. It touches so many people's lives and can cause great hurt which requires healing. There is no judgment of anyone in these circumstances but this should not mean we overlook the truth that each abortion takes an innocent life of a child; their being a "foetus" or "embryo" calls us to give them *more* protection, not less. We cannot in any circumstance endorse or support laws that fail to protect the lives of the unborn. In the UK in 2023 (the most recent statistics) there were almost 300,000 abortions. Many of those in London take place - unnoticed - at the MSI clinic in our parish, on Brixton Hill. Being so close to this place we are called - in particular - to pray for the women who go there and for the repose of the souls of the unborn children who go in but do not come out again. We - as Catholics - are called to witness in a way that is not shrill and loud but calm and compassionate. I was inspired to join - and work for - the charity [LIFE](#) in my twenties because of the positive alternatives they provided for women in crisis pregnancy; counselling, housing, practical support. They also ran (and run) [Zoe's Place](#) hospices for babies with terminal illnesses; helping families say goodbye to their child. They assist the infertile to conceive without the destruction of embryos. LIFE offered (and still offers) hope without judgment and the vision of a radically inclusive love which cherishes born and unborn life. We join our Archbishop this Thursday (whether here or at home) to pray that we may cherish all life.
