As you approach this wonderful day this is an opportunity to remind you of several important actions you need to take:

1. Have you given **notice of your marriage** to Lambeth Council? They will advise you about the collection of your Marriage Schedule which the Church requires (at the very latest) by the time of your wedding rehearsal. More information is [here](#).

Preparing the Order of Service for your Marriage

What follows will enable you to produce a draft Order of Service which guests can be given in order to participate in the liturgy. It is set out in the following order:

1. The Order of Celebrating Matrimony within and without Mass (structure of the rite of Marriage in the Catholic Church)
2. Suggested readings for your wedding day
3. Suggested music for your wedding day

Once you have chosen your readings and music and produced a draft order of service you must send it to the priest for approval before printing.
