- Save a % of our income for emergency repairs & future projects.




How we operated in 2022 - numbers rounded to nearest 100.

Your generosity in the past has allowed us to maintain our wonderful church building. Unfortunately, the recent survey we were legally obliged to conduct identified a number of structural issues we must address urgently in order to preserve the building for the future. As we are not eligible for any Government or Church funding, we must again rely on your support. The survey has estimated that the cost of repairing the building will be around £150,000 and – since we cannot afford this amount currently – we will have to carry out the works over the next three years.

Gift Aid is easy to do, doesn't cost you a giftaid it penny and helps our Parish!

If you are a UK tax payer please consider signing up to Gift Aid – the Parish can claim 25% extra on every pound you donate.

- 71% of donations were Gift Aided in 2022
- Last year, 107 parishioners Gift Aided.
- If more people signed up to Gift Aid, we could receive up to an extra £7,423 each year back from HMRC.

Standing Order is one of the best ways to support our Parish!

A standing order is an instruction to your bank to make regular fixed payments to our Parish. This provides secure, regular income that is easy to Gift Aid, easy to reconcile and takes less time than counting loose change each week. You do not need to worry about getting cash each week for Mass.

You can set up your Standing Order next week all you need is your account number & sort code.
