### **PARISH NEWS**

CATHOLIC BISHOPS RESPOND TO IICSA REPORT: You will have read in the news about the publication of the report by the Independent Inquiry into Child Sexual Abuse (IICSA) in the Catholic Church. This exposed shameful historic incidents in which the paramountcy principle of protecting the vulnerable was not adhered to and the voice of victims not listened to. The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales met this past week and accepted the recommendations of the report and also highlighted IN A RECENT STATEMENT, the outcome of an independent review they commissioned. The recommendations made by the Chair of this review have also been accepted. May all those guilty of exploiting minors (or enabling their exploitation) be brought to justice, victims adequately compensated and all of us increasingly aware of our role in Safeguarding the most vulnerable.

**THANK YOU!** I have been overwhelmed by the number of emails, notes and gifts I have received regarding the news of my appointment as your parish priest. I'm particularly grateful for your promise of prayers and I just want to say "thank you" for your kindness!

**PRE-ADVENT RETREAT (OF SORTS):** I shall be out of the parish from Wednesday next week until we return for the resumption of public worship on Wednesday 2nd December. I am going to make my best effort at a time of retreat by, at least, retreating. During this period I shall offer the Masses listed overleaf in private and our live stream will be suspended. The Church shall continue to be opened for private prayer at the times advertised. For Mass on the First Sunday of Advent I recommend you using **THIS LINK** to join our Archbishop's celebration from St George's Cathedral.

STREAMING OF MASSES: I am sorry for our encountering some problems with the live stream during our Remembrance Service and daily Mass. I feel this illustrates the vulnerability of our stream which I've communicated my concern about previously. It has served us well during the past nine months, however, a more permanent solution is required. I have spoken with ChurchServices.TV who are the company that provide streaming services for a majority of UK Churches including Westminster Cathedral. They can install a fixed camera and audio feed of our sanctuary enabling anyone to view all our services online throughout the year. There would be a significant cost involved (circa £5000 inc. VAT) to install the equipment and then a monthly fee (circa £100 inc. VAT) to run the stream. I believe there will always be a demand for this service not only in light of the pandemic but also for our housebound parishioners who are unable to attend Church for various reasons. If you are enthusiastic about this initiative and in a position of being able to cover (or contribute towards) the cost I would be very grateful to hear from you.

A MESSAGE FROM THE SVP RE CHRISTMAS APPEAL: "This year, more than ever, there are children in very hard-pressed local families who won't get Christmas presents - unless we help. And many older parishioners won't have the means to celebrate this special time. The SVP plans to buy presents for the children and supermarket vouchers for the elderly.
