

Exhilarating and exhausting are the two words that best describe my experience of Easter with you all. We had the most wonderful series of celebrations together and shared a profound spiritual journey which never fails to nourish and encourage us as pilgrims. It took a lot out of so many who tirelessly contributed in so many different ways and I am so grateful to all who gave of their time and talents. Thanks be to God for the great gift of our faith and of our liturgy in which we are truly nourished by His word and His Body and Blood in the Blessed Sacrament of the Altar (which our parish is dedicated to). One of the most moving moments of the Sacred Triduum for me was when - after communion at the Easter Vigil - Fr Mebrate and I drew down the antique brass cradle for our sanctuary lamp and placed the lit candle in it again. As we all sung to our risen Lord we saw the return of the great visual reminder which always burns in our Church but - during the period of Good Friday and Holy Saturday - is temporarily extinguished. What joy it was after experiencing the lack of the Lord Jesus (in remembering His betrayal and death) - to see what the flame symbolises: He had never left us and will never leave us. This is our faith and our hope: God has always - and will always - love us and will never abandon us. Let us ask Him to help all those who doubt the truth of this at this time.
