


We pray for Clement Wray, Michael Sharkey, Robert Devine, Jean Quinn and Alfred Noone who died recently and we remember those whose anniversaries occur at this time including Allana Veeraswamy-Turner, David Boucher, Eleanor Maxwell and Mariana Guga. As the end of term is upon us we pray for all those who are departing for their Easter holidays that they may have safe journeys and experience the joy of the Risen Christ.

The Legion of Mary is a group that gathers to pray together and also carry out the good works of visiting those who are in need in our parish. We are advertising their annual retreat in our Newsletter this week in which they visit our Archdiocesan shrine where Our Lady appeared to St Simon Stock: they travel there to benefit from her intercession and gain spiritual strength to continue in prayer and charity. The Legion is an incredible initiative established in 1921 by the Servant of God Frank Duff and our parish is one of the oldest chapters (or Praesidia) in the Archdiocese. I have benefitted immensely from the Legion's prayerful support and their dedication to a weekly act of charity is inspiring. In the last Secondary School where I was Chaplain I encountered a lot of questions about Our Lady from those who had been told that we Catholics approach her in an idolatrous way that is unacceptable. This is untrue and a misleading and damaging lie that - sadly - draws many back from approaching her. What we will learn in the coming weeks is how crucial Our Lady was in the life of Our Lord. In the Stations of the Cross we traditionally pray the Stabat Mater and so look at the Passion through Mary's eyes and realise the awful implications of her "yes" to God's will. In doing so we realise her prayers can help us - as a model of perfect service - to imitate her perfect worship of her Son.

MASS INTENTIONS: The Mass is the most powerful prayer on earth since it is prayed by Jesus Himself as He offers Himself up on our behalf to the Father. Each Mass is traditionally offered by the priest for a particular intention and - you will notice from this Newsletter - that intentions are recorded in print. It is possible to arrange for a Mass to be said for a particular intention (**for someone living or dead**). To do this you can take an envelope from the Church porch in which it is customary to place a donation which forms a significant part of a priest's annual income. <u>Mass cards</u> can be purchased from the parish office which you can send to relatives who are in mourning.
