We pray for Jozef Mielniczek, Theresa Sinclair and all who have died recently. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. We pray for Francoise Atta who is unwell and remember all who are sick at this time. As the furlough scheme begins to be reduced we remember all of those who may receive the news that they have lost their jobs in the coming weeks. We ask the Lord to comfort them and bring them future employment. We pray for all families affected by the loss of work.

This week we will keep the memorial of Saint Maria Goretti. She was a witness to how - out of the darkest of situations light can shine in this world. An older relative attempted to seduce here and - after she resisted - he murdered her: a story redolent of the case of Sarah Everard this past year. As she was being rushed to hospital she forgave the man who so cruelly objectified her and her witness of unimaginably generous love eventually led him to repent for his wrong. After she was declared a saint for her witness, the same man was present in St Peter's Square celebrating her canonisation. In natural terms we don't understand this: how could it be possible for someone to forgive a man who had done something so terrible? Forgiveness is an incredible struggle for so many who have been the victims of the most appalling behaviour and it is understandable when I hear people tell me "I just can't forgive, Father." That is true. We ourselves on our own - cannot. But we believe forgiving one's enemies is a supernatural act: it's why we pray - in the words Jesus taught us - "forgive us our sins as we forgive those who have sinned against us": by doing this we ask that Jesus may inspire within us the choice to bestow heavenly mercy. Let us also ask St Maria Goretti to help us to forgive!



THINKING OF BECOMING A CATHOLIC? Now IS THE TIME TO ACT! Each year Fr Matthew meets our prospective adult catechumens (those to be baptised) and candidates (those to be confirmed and receive their first holy communion) before the RCIA programme begins in the Autumn. The RCIA programme involves weekly sessions of instruction and discussion about what we believe as Catholics. In order to schedule the one-on-one meetings there is a deadline for applications which is **Friday 9th July**. Please ensure you register your interest before this date by completing our **online form** now.

SAFEGUARDING DBS CHECKS FOR PARISH MINISTRY: Keeping our children and vulnerable adults safe is of paramount importance. To that effect the Archdiocese needs to re-check all parish volunteers every three years. If you have been emailed by the Parish Office with an invitation to begin the process of renewing your DBS please complete the online form by Friday 9th July. Meetings are to take place in the week beginning 12th July and we need time to process the data.
