


We pray for all who have died recently including Miriam White and Pat McBrien. We remember especially those whose anniversaries occur at this time including Alice Joan Webber, Dorothy Northey and Igho Ojaruega. For this whole month of November our Book of Remembrance will remain open - with a different page displayed each day - including the names of the deceased you asked us to pray for. We remember all of those who have died in our parish and - in particular - those who have no one to pray for them.

We were chatting at our Parish Coffee Morning last Thursday about the subject of purgatory. I've written about it before in this space, however, it's always timely to speak of it in this month of the Holy Souls. I was asked by a parishioner what it was and my immediate reaction was "not having got there yet I don't really know!" However, the Church doesn't leave us with that unsatisfactory answer. Within the little Compendium of the Catechism of the Catholic Church (which Joseph can sell you a copy of from the Repository - a good Christmas present!) we are taught: "Purgatory is the state of those who die in God's friendship, assured of their eternal salvation, but who still have need of purification to enter into the happiness of heaven." It is, therefore a place of hope, however, it is also a place where we are purified after death and made capable of experiencing the vision of God without being blinded by His perfect, pure and radiant light. During this month of November we pray for all the "Holy Souls" in purgatory and pray also for ourselves that we may - at the end of our lives - be judged worthy of a place in purgatory so we can be prepared for the joys of heaven.
