

This will be the first proper celebration of Holy Week since I arrived in the parish in September 2019. In my first year here I celebrated the liturgies without any of you being present in Church and it was bizarre and sad. Last year we were able to celebrate but had to limit numbers and remove many key parts of the liturgies; such as the washing of the feet on Maundy Thursday and the Service of Light at the Easter Vigil. In the coming days we will return to being together for these greatest celebrations of our year and as we do so let us savour their meaning and purpose. As we hold palms and walk in procession, join Jesus in Gethsemane at our altar of repose and see the light of His resurrection in the fire at the Easter Vigil, let us pray that we may more deeply appreciate the gift of these celebrations. The Catechism teaches us that the sacraments are outward signs of inward grace and - in all of the liturgies of Holy Week - we are given so many signs through which Jesus truly comes to act in filling our souls and expanding our hearts with His love. There are so many graces to be received by those who attend the liturgies of the Sacred Triduum on Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. I therefore encourage you to simply come and allow the power of God - which is greater than we can imagine - to change you by enabling you to experience the unmerited gift of His perfect love

MASS INTENTIONS: The Mass is the most powerful prayer on earth since it is prayed by Jesus Himself as He offers Himself up on our behalf to the Father. Each Mass is traditionally offered by the priest for a particular intention and - you will notice from this Newsletter - that intentions are recorded in print. It is possible to arrange for a Mass to be said for a particular intention (<u>for someone who has died</u>). To do this you can take an envelope from the Church porch in which it is customary to place a donation which forms a significant part of a priest's annual income. <u>Mass cards can be purchased from the parish office which you can send to relatives who are in mourning.</u>
