


We pray for all who have died recently including Pat McBrien and Monica Ellie. We remember especially those whose anniversaries occur at this time. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. On this day of prayer for prisoners we pray for all the prisoners of our parish up the road in Brixton Prison. We pray for the work of the Catholic Chaplaincy team led by Deacon Joseph and ask that the Lord Jesus may help them to encourage prisoners to increase their faith in the Lord's mercy.

We will celebrate Pope - now Saint - John XXIII's feast this coming Monday. It was Pope John who inaugurated the Second Vatican Council in the 1960s but did not live to see its conclusion which occurred under the leadership of Pope Paul VI in 1965. In calling the Council Pope John XXIII - in his address to the Bishops who were assembled in St Peter's Basilica - he communicated with great pastoral zeal the need to further the mission Jesus entrusted to His disciples. The Council - he said - was not called to be "a discussion of one article or another of the fundamental doctrine of the Church" but "the way in which it is presented". It is nearly fifty years since Pope John XXIII uttered these words inaugurating many changes within the life and practice of the Church. It is, therefore, timely that we pause to reflect upon the way we live our faith in the world and Pope Francis has asked that all Dioceses across the world begin to do this in preparation for a Synod in Rome next year. Archbishop John issued guidelines to parishes last week for how we can all be included in this process (details to follow) and you can read more about the process here. May the Holy Spirit fill us with wisdom as we discern how to be more effective disciples of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

MASS INTENTIONS: The Mass is the most powerful prayer on earth since it is prayed by Jesus Himself as He offers Himself up on our behalf to the Father. Each Mass is traditionally offered by the priest for a particular intention and - you will notice from this Newsletter - that intentions are recorded in print. They are also announced at the start of each Mass. It is possible to arrange for a Mass to be said for a particular intention (maybe for the repose of the soul of a family member or friend who has died). To do this you can take an envelope from the Church porch in which it is customary to place a donation which forms a significant part of a priest's annual income.
