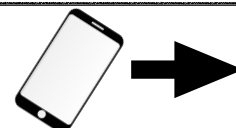

Last weekend was a wonderful celebration: the extended bank holiday felt unique in comparison to usual breaks and it was good to be together in celebration after the 10am Mass to toast Her Majesty. One of the sadnesses was the inability of the Queen to attend the events which she wanted to be at due to her frailty. Sending her apologies must have been difficult for someone who has been so steadfast in representing the country and it brings to mind the challenge of coping with our limitedness. I always remember this being played out in front of our eyes when Pope John Paul II's health began to fail him. In the latter stages of his struggle with Parkinson's he became unable to speak from the balcony at the weekly Angelus and this was evidently a great frustration for him as he - like the Queen - had such a strong sense of duty and responsibility. Yet the great lesson we learn from both of these figures is their coming to accept that which they wouldn't choose but which is necessary for them: reliance upon others. This is an essential part of life's journey and the centre of our spiritual calling: to accept that we cannot do everything ourselves. We need God!

KATHLEEN MULLINS RIP: Her Requiem Mass will be celebrated at Our Lady of the Rosary, Brixton, on Saturday 18th June at 12pm. Her body will be repatriated to Ireland for burial.

CATHOLIC TRUST OF ENGLAND AND WALES: This Sunday's Second Collection is to support the legal, financial and charitable activities of the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales.

DAY FOR LIFE NEXT SUNDAY - SECOND COLLECTION: Next Sunday we celebrate the Annual Day for Life - established by Pope John Paul II - when we pray for all working within the pro-life movement. The Second Collection will go to support the work of the [Anscombe Centre for Bioethics](#) which helps to advise the Catholic Bishops and publish materials to help us deepen our understanding of Church teaching on the dignity of every person from conception to natural death.
