We pray for Katrina Fleming, Joscelyn Ferdinand Haughton-James and Seamus Conlon who died recently and for all whose anniversaries occur at this time. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. As we experience the bitter cold at this time we remember those who have housing difficulties; those who cannot afford their rent, those who suffer under landlords who fail to provide adequate heating, lighting and hot water. We pray they are able to survive in the damp and cold.

We have been listening to the Book of Genesis in the readings for Ordinary Time during the week at the moment. The story of the origin of our first parents is profoundly moving and beautiful. In it we learn that "The Lord God fashioned man out of dust from the soil." We are asked to recall this truth on Wednesday in the traditional formula of words which accompany the (in light of COVID) *sprinkling* of ashes on our heads: "thou art dust and unto dust thou shalt return." This calls to mind our creatureliness; that we were fashioned or moulded into being by our Creator with great tenderness. Within Mark's Gospel - which we are also listening to at present - Jesus' curing of the sick involves Him moulding them too with great tenderness: with the man who is deaf and dumb He puts his fingers into his ears and with the blind man he makes a paste to put in his eyes. In these healings we understand the divinity of Jesus Christ; He is our creator and our sustainer and also our saviour. In his moulding of us - which we see in his behaviour of fashioning the sick with His own hands while on earth - He teaches that the creative act of God didn't cease once we began to be. In fact we can only become who He created us to be when we let Him mould us: let us ask Him to help us to let Him do so this Lent.


