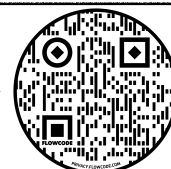
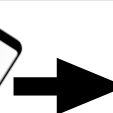

For this whole month of November our Book of Remembrance will remain open - with a different page displayed each day - including the names of the deceased you asked us to pray for. May all past parishioners rest in peace!

We have a beautiful framed record of the names of those who suffered and died in the two World Wars from our parish in the Sacristy. I shall display it on the Sanctuary during all Masses this Sunday as we remember the sacrifice of so many who gave up their lives so that we might live free from tyranny. Amidst the clamour of political disagreement on social media and online we can very often fail to appreciate that the freedom of being able to disagree was not cheap: it was won for us by past generations. It could have been so very different if it weren't for the selflessness of those who were prepared to give up their own lives in favour of the higher ideals of goodness and truth and to oppose their being compromised. The sacrifice of so many brave individuals was a worthy imitation of the God we worship on the cross who teaches us to be willing to make the same sacrifice too. Although we can never rule out another war occurring in our lifetime, it is unlikely that we will be called upon in the same way that they were. However, we should always keep in mind that there are men and women who defend our freedom today in conflicts across the globe: they are prepared - on a daily basis - to risk their lives for us. May we always remember to pray for them; for our armed forces wherever they may be. May God bless them and keep them safe so they can eventually be reunited with their families.
