CHRISTMAS OFFERING 2020: In light of projected Mass attendance being comparatively low this year, the Archbishop has asked that all parish monies received between Christmas Eve and the feast of the Epiphany form part of the Christmas Offering. The Christmas Offering is the largest part of a priest's annual income and I am very grateful to all of you for whatever you are able to give at the current time. If you Gift-Aid your donation the tax can be reclaimed to the benefit of the parish.

SEA SUNDAY: Seafarers are in the news at present and should be in our prayers as many experience uncertainty over the current negotiations with the EU concerning fishing rights. This is the annual Sea Sunday presented by what used to be called The Apostleship of the Sea but is now known as Stella Maris. Stella Maris exists to provide for the spiritual and practical needs of those whose work involves them being at sea for the majority of their time. There is a <u>VERY GOOD VIDEO</u> explaining the necessary pastoral work carried out by Stella Maris chaplains and a page where you can <u>DONATE TO SUPPORT THEIR EFFORTS</u> to ensure those who are vulnerable to difficulties while separated from their families feel the love of the Lord Jesus and experience the presence and concern of others.

ACT TO PREVENT THE DANGER OF ASSISTED SUICIDE: There have been many attempts in recent years to legalise physician assisted suicide in our country which have been defeated in parliament. It is vitally important that we Catholics stand up for the most vulnerable by promoting palliative care instead of killing. The organisation Right To Life is asking us to <u>WRITE TO OUR MPS</u> at this time due to pressure being put upon the Government to consider a change in the law. The danger - as we have seen both in the Netherlands and the state of Oregon - is that a right to die becomes a duty to die irrespective of legal safeguards and the vulnerable feel pressurised. There is a good FAQ <u>HERE</u> to understand the current legal situation and pro-life position on the matter.
