Doesn't it get dark so early now? If you don't like being outside in the darkness then it's highly likely you may have changed routine in some way. Perhaps you go out to the shops a little earlier? I - when it's possible - go on my walk around Brockwell Park earlier in the day. The change from Autumn to Winter is a remarkable and dramatic time of year: the falling leaves and their colour, the cold, the shorter days are impressive and lead to change in our behaviour in other ways too: our clothing, what we choose to eat, turning on the radiators. All this change can be described as adaptation to the season which is necessary and good. We are - significantly - about to change season in the Church's year as we celebrate Christ the King this Sunday: it is the final Sunday of the liturgical year and so it should spark within us a sense of change because what we are preparing for next Sunday is quite different: the holy season of Advent. We will notice a different colour (purple), there will be the advent wreath (and its light) and the liturgy is marked by restraint as the Gloria is omitted. The minimal daylight outside is mirrored by a liturgical minimalism and so the question which follows is: how do we adapt internally to *this* change of season? The way to answer this question is not to do so ourselves but by inviting God to do so for us: "Lord Jesus Christ, how would you like me to change? Please grant me the grace to do so!"
