Thank you! To those who joined us in person and online last Wednesday for our Reconciliation Service (you can watch it here): around 50 of you came (our current capacity) and I was genuinely humbled by your faith in (and love for) our Lord Jesus expressed in your desire to come close to Him and experience His mercy in His sacrament of Confession. It was with joy that so many of you welcomed the Lord Jesus' arrival into your souls (through the grace of his forgiveness) and such an appropriate way to prepare for the greatest week of our year: Holy Week. It's interesting that this greatest of weeks begins in a similar way: we will all welcome the Lord Jesus into Jerusalem on this Palm Sunday: we will hold palms rejoicing in the Good News that He has come to be with us because He loves us. Then the mood changes. After celebration we are called to a more quiet reflection on the radical nature of the love that He came to offer us. That love is heard of through the scripture readings and understood in the liturgical gestures we will witness. On Maundy Thursday we will watch online by candlelight as we remain with Him in his deepest agony: as He waited for what He knew would be so cruel. On Good Friday we will see very little as our Church is stripped bare and we remember Him being stripped bare too. And although - as Isaiah will teach us - He became "a thing despised and rejected" in these days He loved us still. Thank you Lord Jesus for loving me and help me to grow this Holy Week in my love for you!



LAST OPPORTUNITY FOR CONFESSION BEFORE EASTER: I will be hearing Confessions on **Good Friday between 10am and 12pm** socially distanced in the Hall and you are welcome to come to prepare prayerfully in the Church: see my reflection on Confession before coming. I will provide an examination of conscience and a guide to confession on the day so do not worry if you feel a bit unsure about what to do or say: you will find help! Confession is the best way to prepare for the new life Jesus comes to bring us this Easter. Come - if you can - to experience His mercy!

SPY WEDNESDAY MASS TIME CHANGE: For those of you attending our mid-week Masses please note that our Mass this coming Wednesday will be <u>at the earlier time of 9am</u>. All the clergy of the Archdiocese gather with Archbishop John Wilson at St George's Cathedral to celebrate the Chrism Mass at 11:30am and so the change of time is necessary in order for me to arrive in good time. It is the Mass at which we renew our priestly vows and a time to pray for all clergy that we may be given the grace to imitate our Lord Jesus Christ with greater fidelity each day.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS TO PRINT FOR THE HOUSEBOUND: I have prepared our stations of the cross in PDF format. In speaking to many of our housebound parishioners who do not use the internet it is a sadness they are unable to participate in the stations (yet again) this Holy Week.
